Worship Miniseries: EfM Informational Meeting

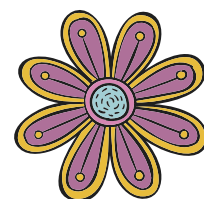
Sunday, Aug 16 | 6:30 PM on Zoom
