Welcome back! We have been delighted to see you all this week looking refreshed and ready for the next half term ahead.

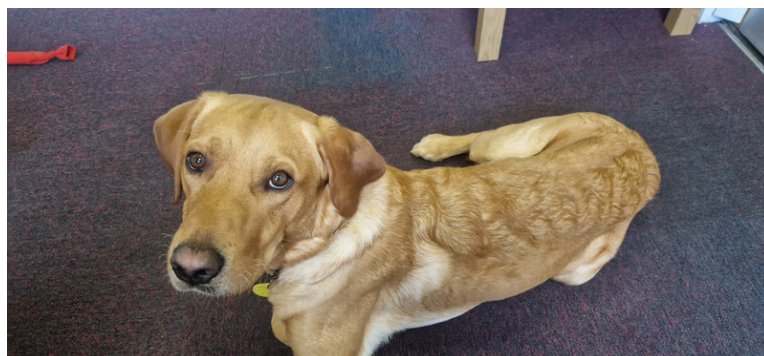
Attendance Progress
