In the **process** of/ in the course of doing something

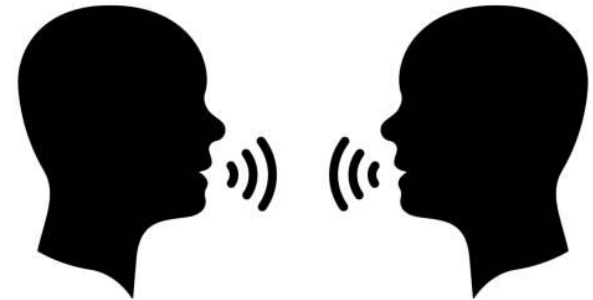

Can you use this word in a sentence?

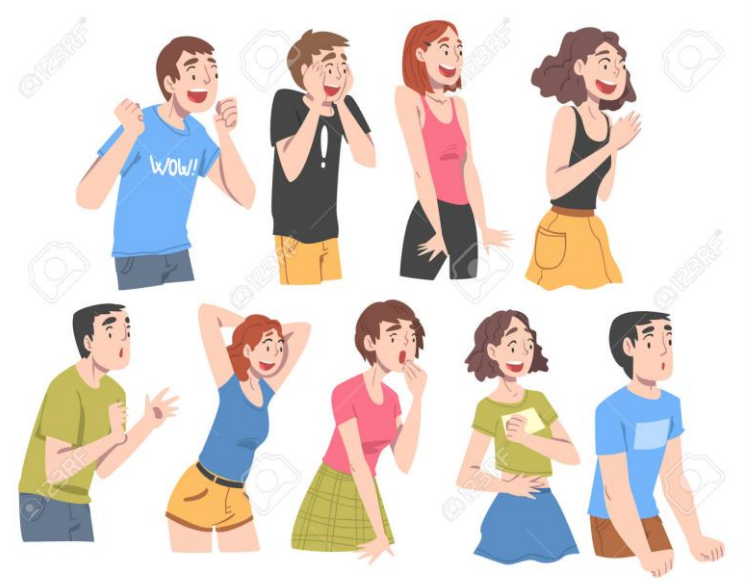


Reaction

‘A chemical change when substances act upon each other.’



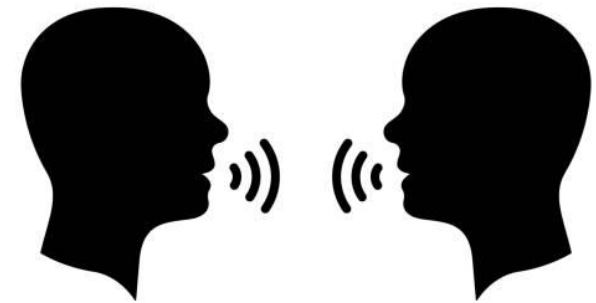

‘To improve something, especially by making small changes.’

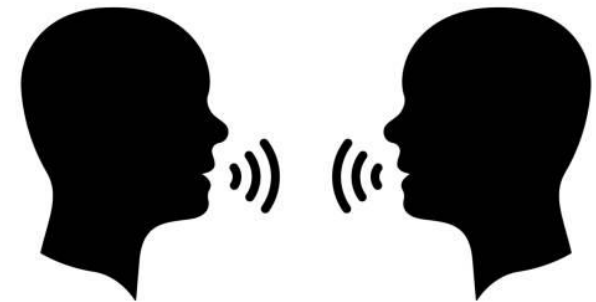


