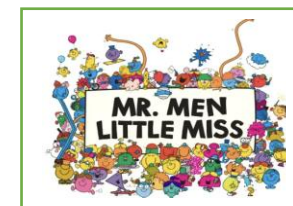

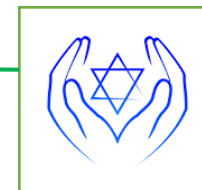
Judaism - We will learn that:
