<u>Calderdale Cross Finals 2025 - The full report!</u>

On Wednesday 26th November 31 children from KS2 represented our school and the Local Schools Family Team at the Calderdale Cross Country Finals at The Old Brodlieans.

They competed as either part of a team or as individual runners. Team scores were calculated by adding the best four finishing positions from five runners, so the best possible score was 10 (1st, 2nd,3rd $\& 4^{th}$).

The Year 3&4 children raced approximately 1100m and the Year 5&6 children raced approximately 1350m. There were between 50 and 66 children in each race.

All our children were absolutely amazing, showing great levels of grit and determination to either help their team qualify or to finish in the first 20 individual places. We are thrilled that 29 children have now qualified for the West Yorkshire Finals on Tuesday 3rd March at Temple Newsam.

An extra shout out to Milo who won the Year 4 boys race making him a Calderdale Champion and helping his team secure qualification!
