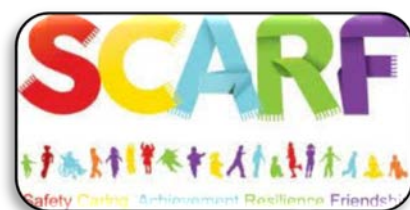


NF1 Awareness Day

A polite reminder to complete the PSHE survey sent out this week. Parental contributions are highly valued, and your feedback is greatly appreciated.



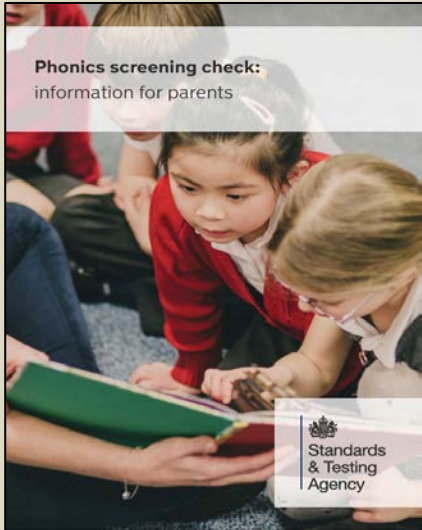
