Voice 21 – Oracy Accreditation

We are proud to be working towards Voice 21 Oracy Accreditation this year, further strengthening speaking and listening across our school. Building on the strong foundations of our *Lightcliffe 100*, which enriches pupils' vocabulary, we are helping children become confident, articulate communicators who can express their ideas with clarity and confidence.



Lightcliffe 100 – vocabulary acquisition

At Lightcliffe, we recognise the vital role of oracy in language development. It lays the foundation for writing and supports the development of linguistic confidence and competence into adulthood. To support this, we teach a carefully selected range of Tier 2 vocabulary—high-frequency words that appear across a wide variety of academic subjects and texts.

Tier 2 vocabulary is:

- found across many types of texts and subjects;
- often used more in written language than in spoken language;
- crucial for understanding instructions, questions, and academic content;
- capable of having multiple meanings depending on context.

Each week, three new Tier 2 words are introduced to every class. Teachers explain their meanings, word class, and how they are used in context. These words are revisited annually, allowing children to consolidate and deepen their understanding over time.

Through this consistent and progressive approach, children at Lightcliffe Primary acquire and begin to use Tier 2 vocabulary confidently—developing their language for learning, for life, and for their futures.

We began this week with our first three words: *accurate* *achieve* *acquire*
