

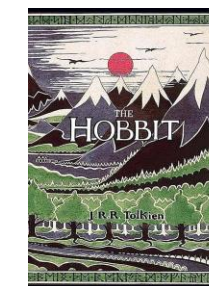
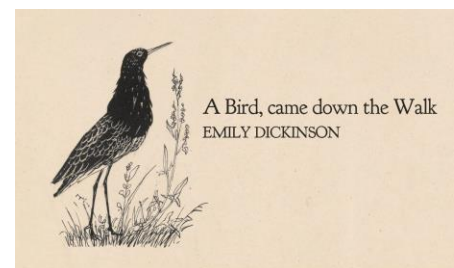
Christian Values

We will also apply these arithmetic skills through word problems and unit measurement reasoning questions.

English
