Maths

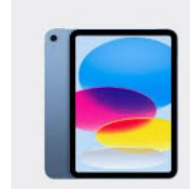
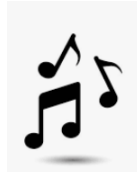

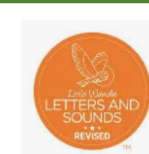


HOW CAN YOU HELP?
