Humanities

Our focus this half term is Vikings! Specifically, the overarching key question "What was the impact of the Viking invasion of Britain?" We will be comparing this to previous learning of the Roman Invasion. I would recommend 'Vikings by Mary Pope Osborne' book if you want to immerse yourself in some home reading.
