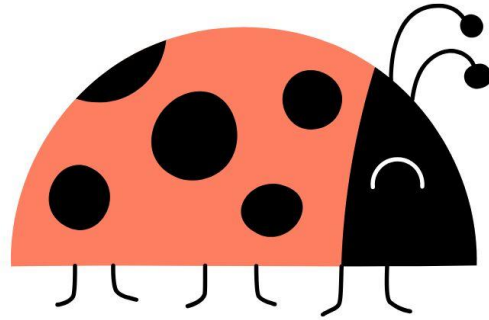

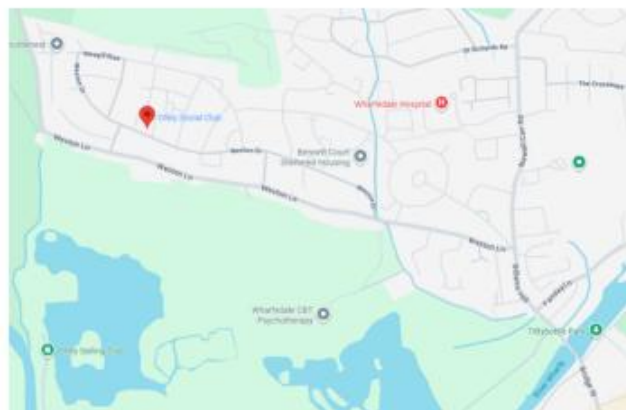

LaunchPad Sports Club

Making sport accessible, enjoyable and inclusive

Thursdays 3.15-4.15pm

LaunchPad Football is the original School Series programme and has recently become the biggest extra curricular football club in the North of England. Teams are formed within year groups or key stages and matches are played each week across the term. Coaching happens through the game so children learn positioning, decision making and movement while they play. Sessions are inclusive, structured and fun, with clear routines that build confidence and teamwork.

Mondays 3.15-4.15pm

LaunchPad Multi Sports gives children the opportunity to explore twelve different sports across the school year. Each sport runs for three weeks so pupils can enjoy variety while building coordination and confidence. Sessions combine team games, individual challenges and competitions that reward participation and adaptability.

Tuesdays 3.15-4.15pm

LaunchPad Kitchen introduces pupils to the joy of cooking and baking. Each week brings a new recipe or creative challenge inspired by popular food shows. Pupils learn key skills, explore flavours and take pride in their dishes. Sessions focus on teamwork, creativity and curiosity about food.
