
#### Working with Voice 21

Overall, the day celebrated the richness of talk embedded in our learning community and the positive impact it has on every learner. It was a pleasure to be part of it.





#### How to book:

Children who are eligible for income related free school meals will get 100% funding support to attend and will have lunch provided. Places are limited and available on a first come first served basis.

**SEND** - If your child would require 1to1 support to attend, please call us on 01133226115 as we do have a limited amount of staff and need to plan this accordingly so that all the children can have a positive experience.
