LaunchPad Sports Club

Making sport accessible, enjoyable and inclusive

Mondays 3.15-4.15pm - KS1* and KS2

LaunchPad Multi Sports gives children the opportunity to explore twelve different sports across the school year. Each sport runs for three weeks so pupils can enjoy variety while building coordination and confidence. Sessions combine team games, individual challenges and competitions that reward participation and adaptability.

**Please note that due to the nature of the activities within this club, if there are not enough KS1 attendees the club will not run for KS1. If you are interested please do still sign up. Payment will not be taken until LaunchPad have confirmed that there are enough child to take part.*

Tuesday 3:15pm-4:15pm – KS1 and KS2

LaunchPad Gaming, Puzzles & Digital Play Club allows children to explore board games, strategy games such as chess and draughts, LEGO construction, robotics and themed mystery challenges. Each week offers a new puzzle or build that promotes focus, patience and teamwork. The digital play aspect of the club helps children build teamwork, communication and strategy in a safe and structured setting. Games change every two weeks and focus on cooperation and creative problem solving. Pupils plan together, play together and reflect on their teamwork after each session. As part of the club children partake in interactive games such as Task Master, Crystal Maze to spark creativity and problem solving.

Sessions are inclusive, structured and fun, with clear routines that build confidence and teamwork.
