Year 6 – Saltburn-by-the-sea Trip

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are delighted to inform you that on Wednesday 17th June 2026 to celebrate the approach towards the end of Year 6, we will be visiting Saltburn-by-the-sea. I would like to say there is some education value in taking the children there but honestly, it is just an opportunity to wind down for the year (almost) and allow the children a change of scenery to relax and have fun! We are praying for sunshine! As the trip is quite a distance and the trip is by the sea, I would appreciate the following information be read very carefully.

We will be travelling by coach and the children will need to be at school for 8.00am on Wednesday 17th June; we are leaving school, promptly, at 8:15am. It is crucial that children are on time as to avoid delays on the road. The children will be back in school for normal time and should be collected at the usual 3:15pm from the front of school - unless they walk home alone.

The children are allowed to wear their own clothes but please ensure clothing and footwear is suitable for walking along the beach, playing games on the sand etc. I encourage swimming stuff to be worn underneath clothes when travelling there. They must bring a towel, change of clothes, spare socks and weather appropriate measures must be taken e.g. sun-cream, waterproofs, cap etc.

Although we are going to be by the sea, there is no obligation at all for the children to take a dip. The children will not be allowed to enter the water beyond a shallow depth – I will be stood very clearly at a point at which the children cannot pass – and weaker swimmers can simply dip their toes in. They will be supervised at all times. We will ‘camp out’ on the beach as a base and the children will be allowed to play within eyesight of adults.

The children are having chips for their lunch (please read below), but you may wish to pack an extra snack if necessary. A throw away water bottle is recommended as to avoid losing the more expensive reusable one. (Though the environmentalist in me would rather we use reusable ones!)





We kindly request a contribution of £23 per child towards the cost of the visit. This will include chips* on the pier, transport to and from Saltburn and an ice cream. No child will be denied the opportunity to take part in the visit in the event of parents/carers being unable to pay the contribution. In cases of hardship, you are invited to speak in confidence to Mrs Marsland (or another senior member of staff in her absence). However, please note that if insufficient contributions are received the visit may have to be cancelled and all monies returned. Please complete the online form by following the link below by Monday 8th June to grant permission for your child to attend the trip. Please login to Arbor to make payment.

*The chips on the coast are cooked traditionally and are therefore not vegetarian or Halal. If you would rather your child bring their own food, you can send them with a packed lunch. FOOSC are very generously funding the cost for the chips and ice cream and this has been taken off the overall cost of the trip for each child.
