A MONTH TO HONOR BY BILL NOCITA, CAMPUS MINISTER

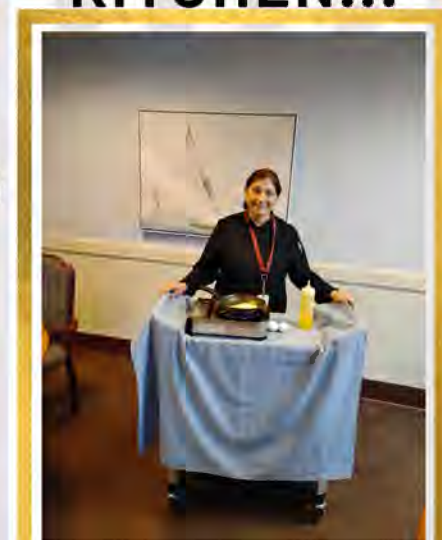
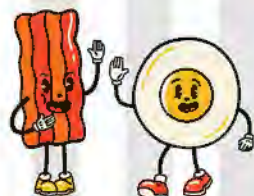

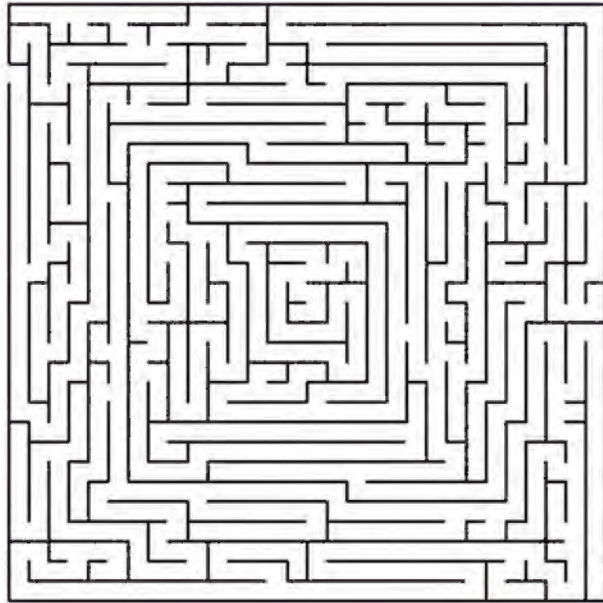
