- Have you ever been mad that your sibling was forgiven by your parent? How is that like this parable?
- What is separating you from God's love?

FOR PARENTS

Today we learned how the Parable of the Prodigal Son should really be Sons because both sons were disconnected from the love of the father. The younger son was selfish and wanted to do things his own way. The older son was prideful and assumed he was right. He didn't know the father well enough to understand the father's love and forgiveness. Jesus ended the story without telling us what choice the older son makes. Why? Because Jesus wanted people to think about what choice they would make.
