Revival Under King Josiah (2 Kings 22–23; 2 Chronicles 34–35)

When the King heard the words of the Book of the Law, he tore his clothes.
2 Kings 22:11 ESV

Neither before nor after Josiah was there a king like him who turned to the Lord as he did—with all his heart and with all his soul and with all his strength, in accordance with all the Law of Moses.

2 Kings 23:25 NIV

Revival Under King Hezekiah (2 Chronicles 29–31)

They sanctified themselves and cleansed the house of the Lord.

(2 Chronicles 29:15–17)

There was great joy in Jerusalem, for since the days of Solomon son of David king of Israel there had been nothing like this in Jerusalem.

2 Chronicles 30:26 NIV

Revival Under Ezra and Nehemiah (Nehemiah 8–9)

They read from the Book of the Law of God, making it clear and giving the meaning so that the people understood what was being read.

Nehemiah 8:8 NIV

“...the Joy of the Lord is your strength.”

Revival During Samuel’s Leadership (1 Samuel 7)

And Samuel said to all the house of Israel, “If you are returning to the Lord with all your heart, then put away the foreign gods...”

Nineveh and Jonah (Jonah 3)

When God saw what they had done and how they had put a stop to their evil ways, he changed his mind and did not carry out the destruction he had threatened.
