Why John's Gospel Is Different?

Matthew — Proclaims Jesus as the Promised King of Israel

Mark — Proclaims Jesus as the Servant of God

Luke — Proclaims Jesus as the Perfect Son of Man

John — Proclaims Jesus as the Eternal God in the Flesh

Believe in Jesus and Receive the Life that He Offers (John 20:31)

The Seven Miracles of Jesus in the Gospel of John

Jesus Turns Water into Wine. John 2:1-11

- Revealing His power over creation

Jesus Heals the Nobleman's Son. John 4:46-54

- Revealing His authority over sickness and distance

Jesus Heals the Lame Man. John 5:15

Jesus Feeds the Five Thousand. John 6:1-14

- Revealing that Jesus is the provider of all we need

Jesus Walks on Water. John 6:16-21

- Reveals and demonstrates His authority over nature

Jesus Heals the Blind Man. John 9:1-41

- Revealing that Jesus is the Healer and the Light of the World

Jesus Raises Lazarus from the Dead. John 11:1-44

- Boldly proclaiming that Jesus is Lord over death

The Seven "I Am" Statements in John

1. I am the Bread of Life. John 6:35

- Jesus satisfies our deepest hunger; apart from Him people remain spiritually empty

2. I Am the Light of the World. John 8:12

- Jesus brings truth into the darkness. He leads us, exposes sin, and reveals God.

3. I Am the Door. John 10:9

- Jesus is the only way to salvation. There is no other way.

4. I Am the Good Shepherd. John 10:11

- Jesus knows His sheep and He knows you. He leads and protects them and lays down His life for them

5. I Am the Resurrection and the Life. John 11:25

- Jesus has the final word, not death. Life is found in Christ alone.

6. I Am the Way, the Truth, and the Life. John 14:6

- Jesus is not merely one way among many ways to God and salvation; He is the only way!

7. I Am the True Vine. John 15:1

- Life, spiritual growth and fruitfulness come through abiding in Christ. Apart from Him, we can do nothing.

Why is John So Important to Every Person?

Belief — What will you do with Jesus?

Life — Jesus doesn't simply offer existence, but abundant life

The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life and have it to the full.

John 10:10 NIV

Light — Jesus shines into the darkness of the world

The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness can never extinguish it.

John 1:5 NLT

Love — The amazing love of God

For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son...

John 3:16 NIV

Abiding — A life with Jesus is not about striving but about abiding

Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me.

John 15:4 NKJV
