The North Queensland Super Hub (NQSH) is a renewable energy precinct designed to power Queensland's low-carbon future while supporting regional communities.

NQSH is being developed by Windlab and Fortescue, building on the lessons learned through Windlab's successful delivery of the Kennedy Energy Park.

About Wongalee



Up to 1.4GW of wind energy

The Wongalee Wind Energy Project (Wongalee), located on Yirendali Country, will generate up to 1.4GW of renewable energy.



Located in the Flinders Shire

Wongalee is located on Yirendali Country, in the Flinders Shire on pastoral land north east of Hughenden, about 300km south-west of Townsville, Queensland.



Quality resource, grid-ready

The Wongalee location provides access to a quality wind resource and is ideally located in proximity to CopperString which will connect North West Queensland to the National Electricity Market.



Coexisting with agriculture

The project will coexist with the region's agricultural industry, deliver important benefits to local communities and play a key role in supporting Queensland's critical decarbonisation objectives.



Approvals progressing

Wongalee secured State Development Approval in 2025 and is now progressing through Commonwealth assessment under the EPBC Act.



Working closely with community

As the projects continue to progress, we remain focused on working closely with landholders, Traditional Owners, Council and the broader community to ensure the benefits are shared across the region.

Social Impact Assessment

The project team have engaged ERM to deliver a **Social Impact Assessment (SIA)** for the Prairie and Wongalee projects.

The SIA will identify and assess potential social impacts associated with the projects and help inform planning and decision-making as development progresses.

The assessment will support the development of management measures aimed at responsibly avoiding, minimising and managing impacts.

All proposed renewable energy developments in Queensland require distinct approvals from Local, State and Federal Government authorities.

The project is being assessed under the Federal Government's **Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation (EPBC) Act**, which protects nationally significant plants, animals, ecology and heritage places.

In June, you will have a formal opportunity to provide feedback on the Wongalee Wind Farm as part of the EPBC Act public comment period.

Community Benefit Framework

The SIA will also help inform the development of a Community Benefit Framework focused on delivering enduring regional value through:

- Local employment
- Procurement opportunities
- Skills development
- Targeted community investment.

Respecting Country

Wongalee is located on the traditional lands of the Yirendali Peoples. We are committed to protecting their cultural heritage and values, and working together to ensure enduring benefits for their people. Windlab and the Yirendali Aboriginal Corporation co-designed a **Shared Benefits Agreement** and **Cultural Heritage Management Agreement** that was signed in March 2024.

The Wongalee EPBC Public Comment period is open until Tuesday 7 July. Feedback received during this time will inform updates to project documentation, prior to final submission later in the year.
