# Application Requirements



The Principal Applicant and family must meet all of the requirements:

- Be at least 18 years old.
- Have no criminal record or be under investigation, or involved in any activity likely to cause disrepute to the country.
- Have not been denied a visa to any country to which citizens of St Kitts & Nevis have visa-free travel and has not subsequently obtain a visa to the country that issued the denial.
- Make a significant economic contribution.



The following family members can be included in the application

- Spouse of the principal applicant
- Children under 18 years old
- Unmarried Children 18-29 years old who are financially dependent on the Principal Applicant.
- Children 18+ years with physical or mental disabilities.
- Parents of the Principal Applicant or spouse, if they are above the age of 55 and fully supported by the Principal Applicant.

# Investment Options



Applicants should choose one of the following non-refundable contribution options:

1. A contribution of US\$250,000 to the Sustainable Island State Contribution (SISC) fund:

- No processing fees for the main applicant with up to three dependants.
- US\$25,000 for each additional dependant under 18.
- US\$50,000 for each additional dependant aged 18.

2. A contribution of US\$250,000 to a Government-approved Public Benefit Option (PBO):

- No processing fees for the main applicant.
- \$10,000 for each dependent under 18.
- \$15,000 for each dependent aged 18+.

# Application Process



## Documentation and Timeline

All applicants are thoroughly vetted by the Citizenship by Investment Unit. Required documentation to be submitted includes:

- birth certificates
- passport copies
- police clearances
- medical reports
- source of funds

Additionally, applicants are required to:

- attend a virtual interview
- submit biometric information

In most cases, applications are processed within 4 to 6 months.
