Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> January

**PERFORMING ARTS:** Work with a Professional Puppeteer

Join puppeteer Polly Beestone and discover how puppets can transform storytelling and performance. Learn professional techniques for creating character, movement and voice before bringing your own puppet performance to life.

Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> February

**GEOGRAPHY:** Are natural disasters actually natural?

Explore some of the world's most dramatic disasters and uncover the surprising role humans can play in them. You'll discover why geography is about far more than maps.

Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> February

**ART:** The Ripple Effect: How can one action change many lives?

Experiment with printmaking and digital techniques to explore showing how a single positive action spreads outward like ripples. Work with specialist staff to produce a range of work suitable for your portfolio.

**HISTORY:** Could your words change the world?

Inspired by the MPs who once lived at Eartham House, explore some of history's most influential speeches and discover how ideas become action. Then put your own public-speaking skills to the test in an engaging, confidence-building workshop.

**SPORTS:** Train with a Team GB junior athlete and discover what it takes to compete at the highest level. From training routines and nutrition to resilience and mindset, gain an insight into life as an elite young athlete.

## Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> November

**SCIENCE:** "Future Shapers of Our Planet"  
Learn about the impacts of some of the most notable environmental scientists of our time, and will be encouraged to solve some of the most pressing issues facing humanity. Local projects: Global ambition.

**MATHS:** Explore cryptology through the ages. Starting with Egyptian hieroglyphics and moving onto Alan Turing code breaking in WW2 and investigating cyber security in modern society.

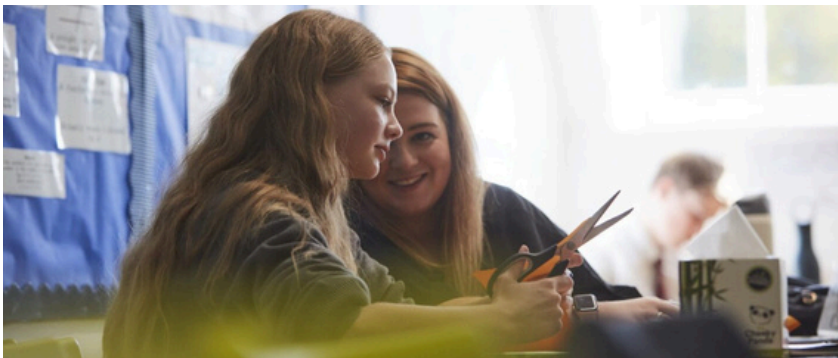
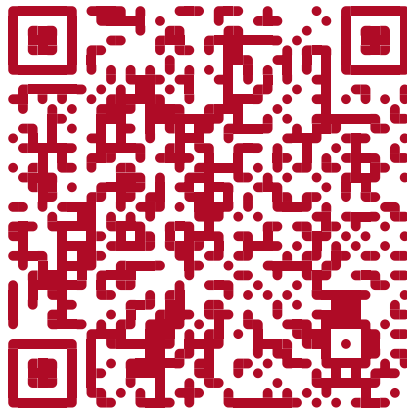
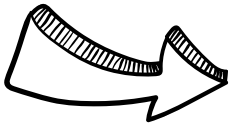
