



The mock oral exams simulate-as closely as possible-the real oral board exams. Each participant appears once before a pair of examiners. When participants are not taking the mock oral board exams, they are encouraged to visit the various exam rooms to observe others. Periodontists who passed the oral board exam have reported that the mock oral board exam process improved their oral test-taking skills and self-confidence.


