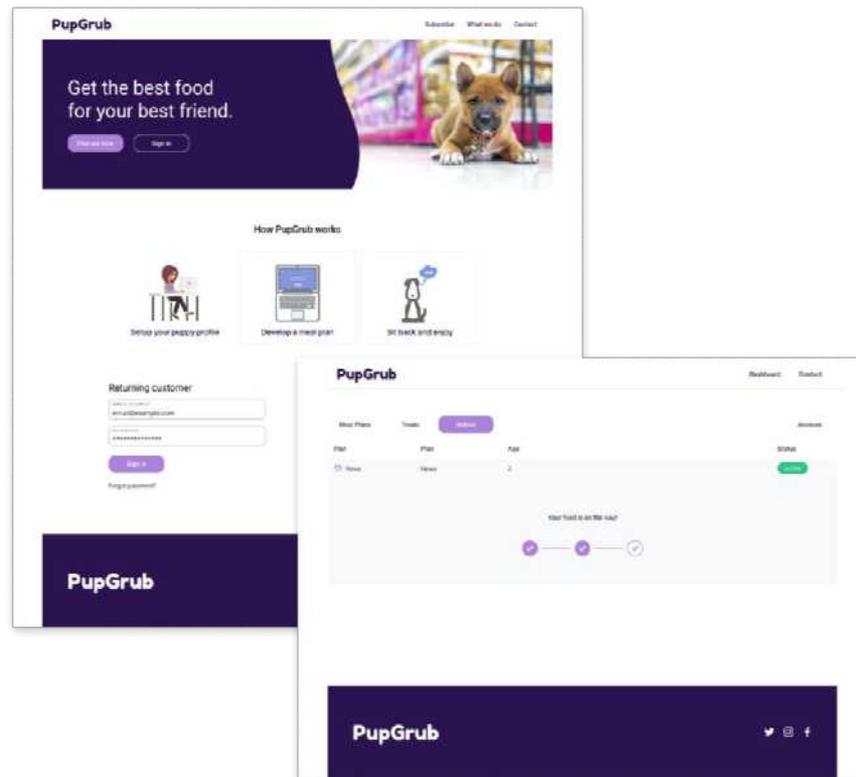
The product:

Project overview



The problem:

Ordering from a subscription based dog food vendor while trying to track when the food will arrive.



The goal:

An app that will let users place and monitor the status of orders before and during the shipping process. In addition, the app will provide an easy way to add dog treats to the orders for multiple pets.

Project overview



My role:

UX designer designing an app for subscription based dog food vendor.



Responsibilities:

Conducting interviews, paper and digital wireframing, low and high-fidelity prototyping, conducting usability studies, account for accessibility, and iterating on designs.

User research: summary



I conducted interviews to gain a better understanding on how people have ordered dog food.

The user group revealed several new possible additions/features. The research showed that some of the major pain points a user might experience are related to the massive amount of options, food ingredients, and reputation of the dog food manufacturer.

Serena is a 30-year-old pet groomer who needs an easy and reliable way to find healthy dog food options because she wants more time to spend with her family and pets.

Bio

Serena is a 30-year-old pet groomer who loves caring for her 3 dogs. She often helps her family by grooming their pets. She loves providing healthy and tasty dog food for her furry friends, however, it can be a very time consuming process.

When their preferred brand is out of stock it can be a very time-consuming process researching the ingredients in different brands. They are also concerned with the lack of transparency of brands and if there have been any recalls in the past.

Goals

- Display ingredients of each product clearly.
- Suggested toppers, treats, or other dog food brands.
- Ratings for each brand.

Frustrations

- Wants to make sure there're no byproducts and that the food has the nutrients that the dog needs.
- Wants something that says this topper or treat goes great with this dog food.
- While shopping for dog food online, it can a long time to look up the ingredients of each product per pet.

Persona: Adam

Problem statement:

Adam is a 36-year-old network administrator who wants a reliable dog food service that can deliver for a reasonable price so he doesn't have to try one or more stores.

Bio

Samuel is a 36-year-old newly wed who married into being a first time dog owner. He often feels overwhelmed with all of the dog food options at the store. He loves his puppy and wants to make sure the food is both good for his dog while still being affordable.

They want the process of finding and purchasing good quality dog food to be simplified. They often find themselves frustrated with all of the options available and not knowing what ingredients would be beneficial.

Goals

- Wants a simple way to view what ingredients are good for his dog
- Reliable delivery of his preferred brand
- Alternative suggestions if his preferred brand is out of stock

Frustrations

- Wants an easier way to find good deals
- Doesn't like having to read through all of the ingredients for each brand
- Going to the store only to find out that his preferred brand is out of stock

Knowing how our customer navigates the application will help uncover possible problems or opportunities

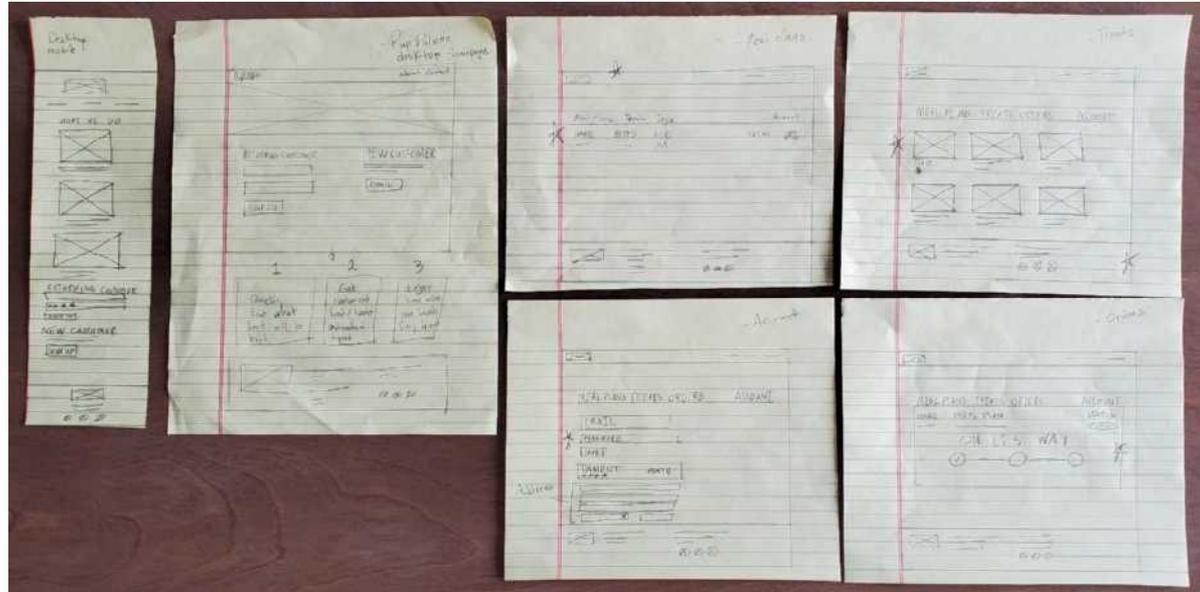

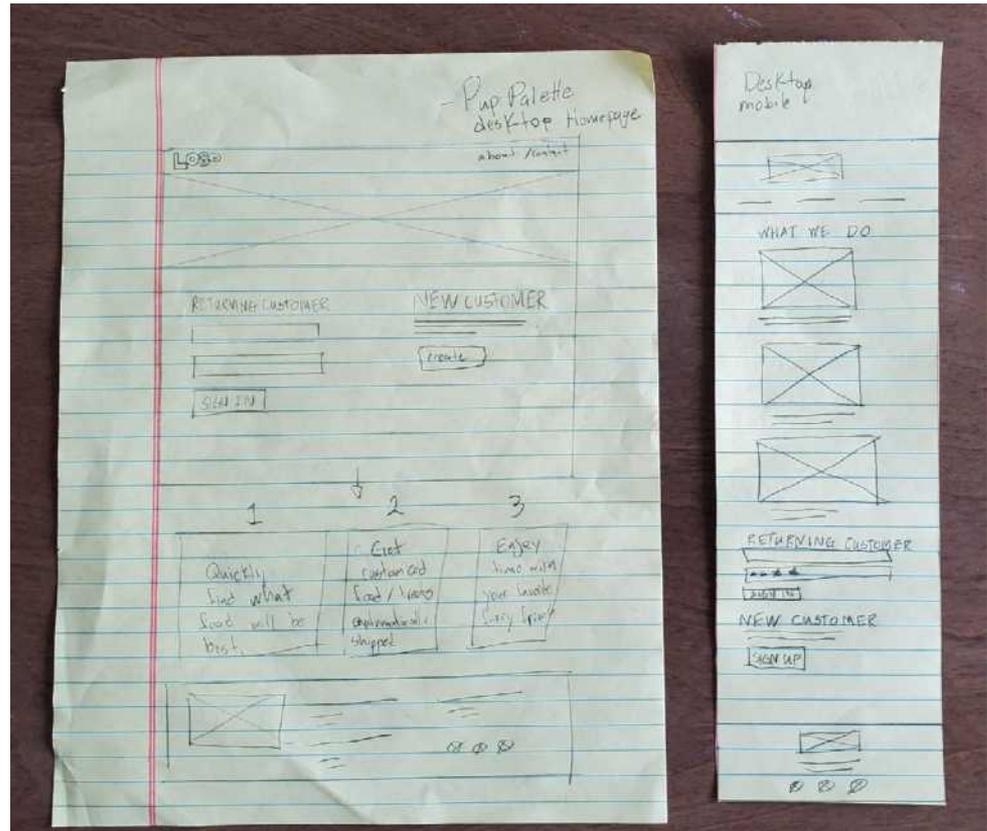
Paper wireframes

Paper wireframes screen size variations

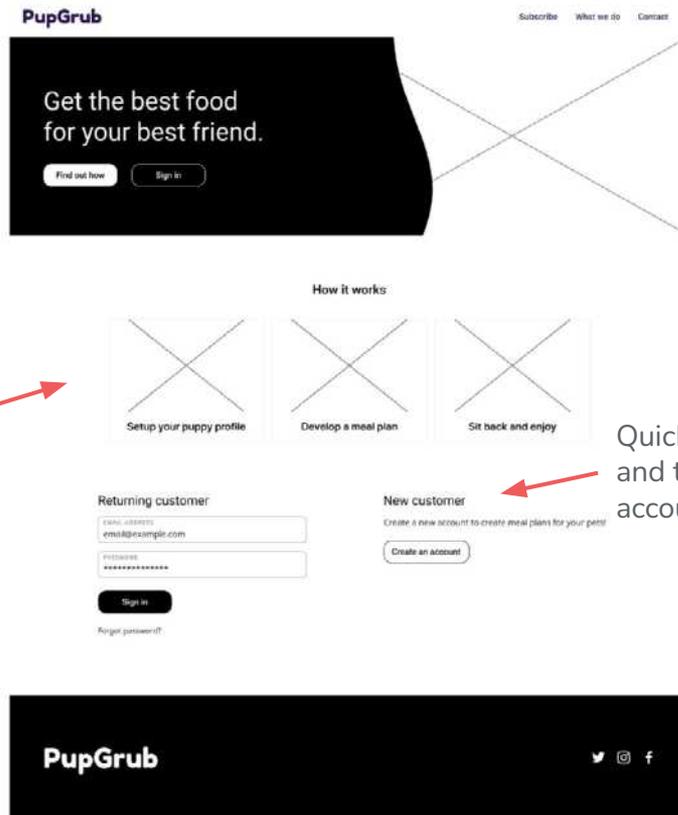
A mobile version of each page was also sketched during this phase.

For the homepage, easy access to information on the service and the ability to login/create an account.

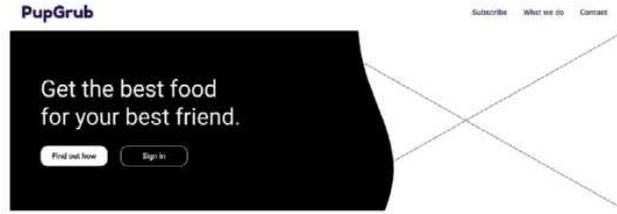
Engaging (fluffy) imagery is the main focal point.

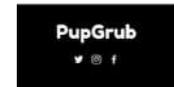

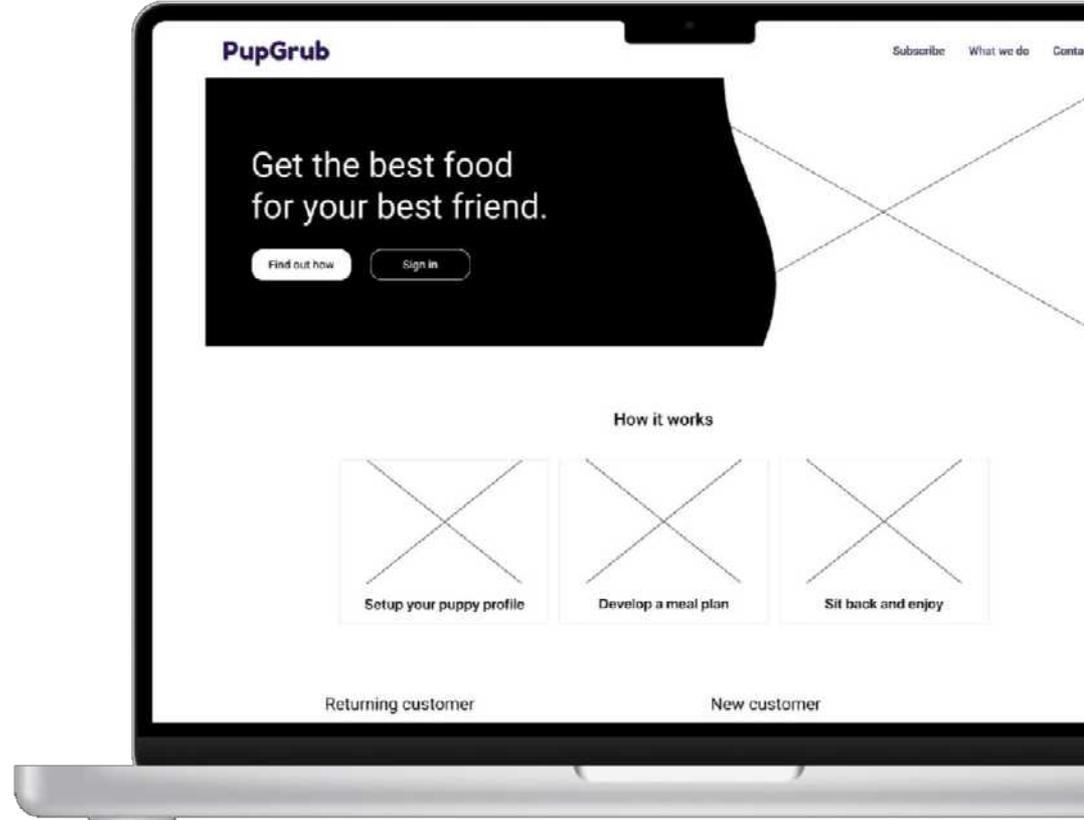

Low-fidelity prototype

The low-fidelity prototype connected the primary user flow of navigating the application so the prototype could be used in a usability study with users.

Usability study: findings

I conducted a usability study with 5 participants in an unmoderated environment. Users were given a set of tasks to complete and a brief questionnaire to fill out at the end.

Round 1 findings

- 1 Users found the navigation confusing
- 2 Users want an easy way to track their order
- 3 Users want a way to add separate subscriptions for each pet

Round 2 findings

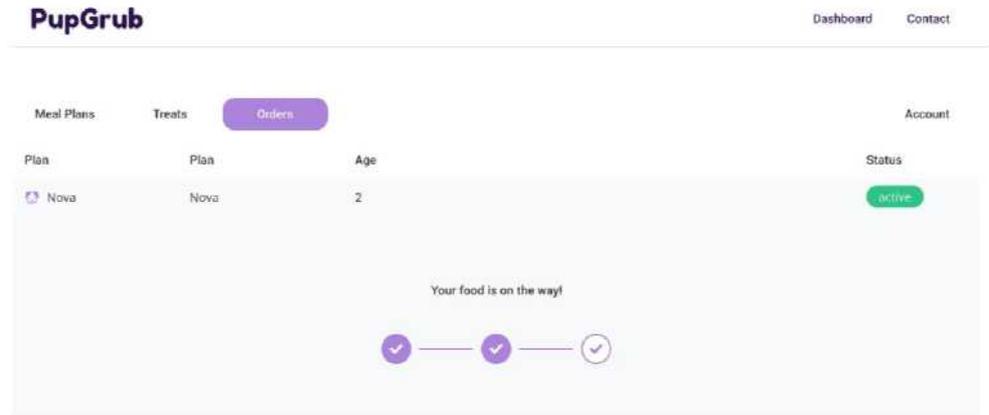
- 1 Users found navigating the app an easy and fluid process
- 2 Users are pleased that they're able to track each subscription
- 3 Users liked like the simple administrative dashboard

The Orders page gives users the ability to track meal plans, order treats, and track each subscription for each pet.

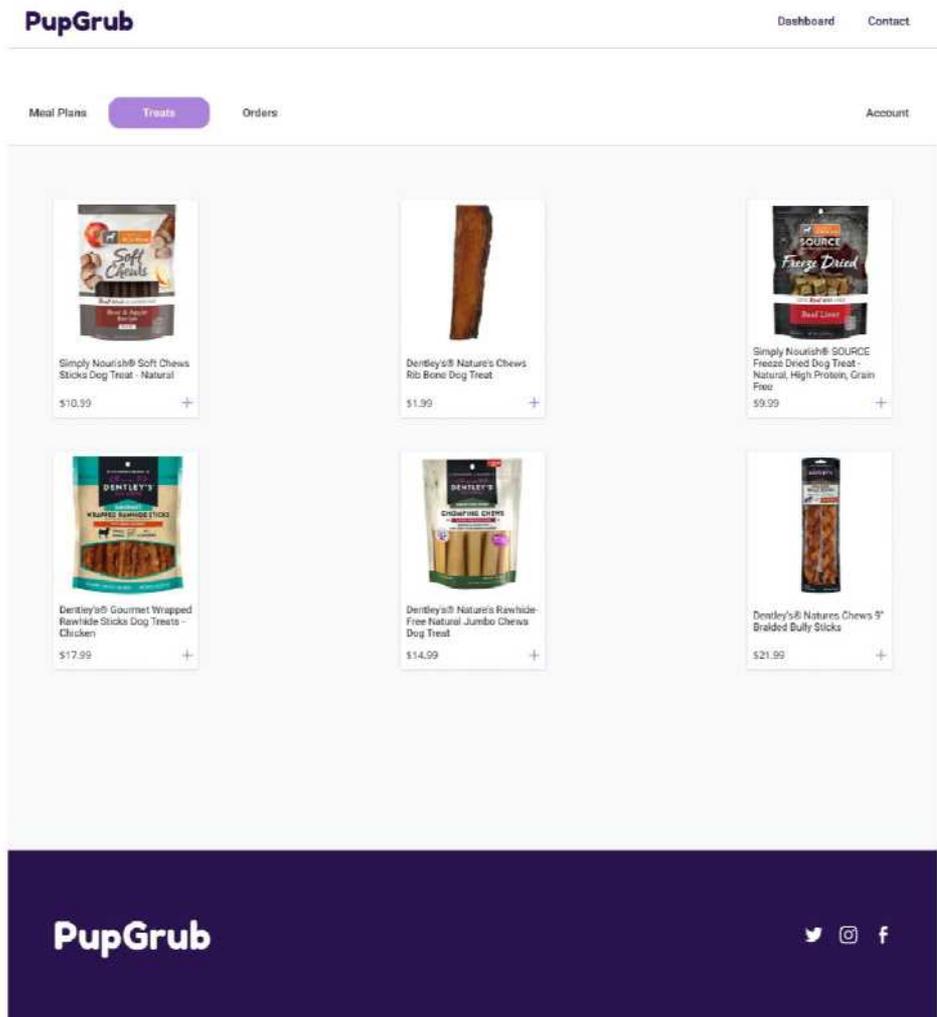

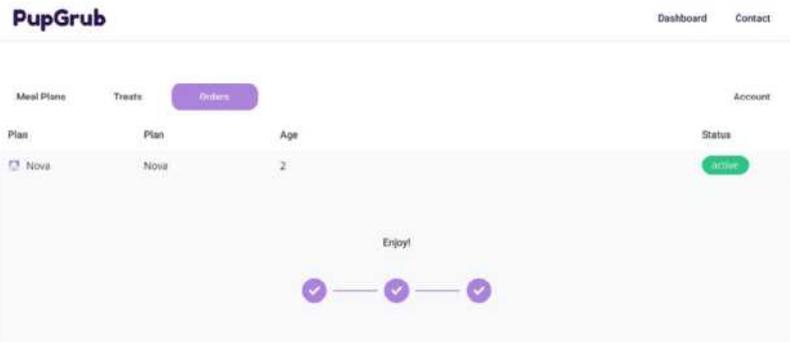

Multiple meal plans for multiple pets

Users need a way to create and manage meal plans for multiple pets.

Tracking each meal plan separately

Users need to be able to track the status for each meal plan separately.

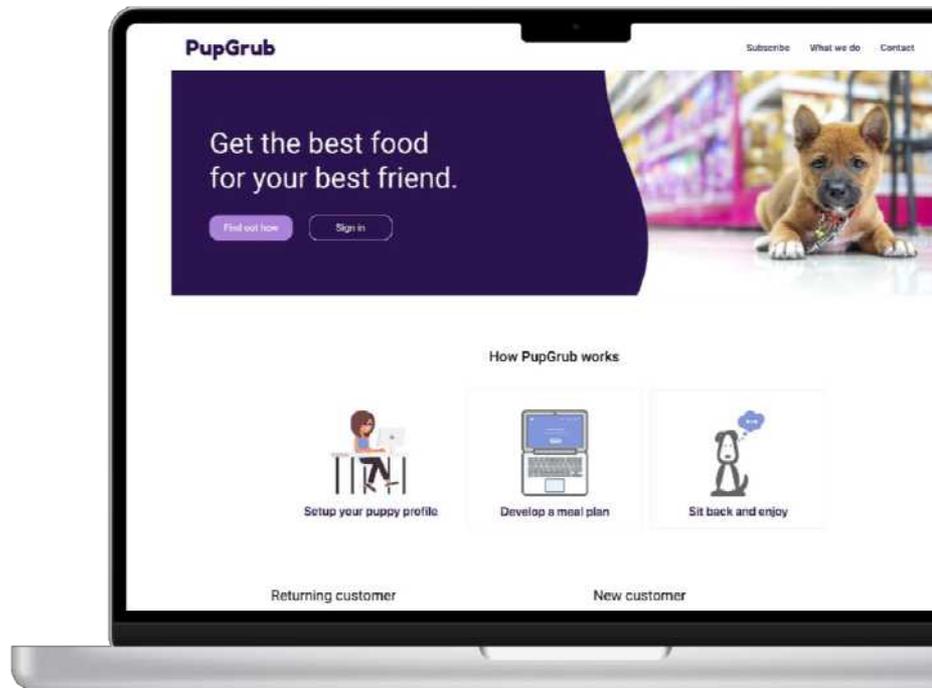
Able to update address and payment info

Users need a way to update their shipping address and payment information.

The high-fidelity prototype introduced several new screens and features that addressed issues found during the testing phase.

Accessibility considerations

1

Colors used in the app were chosen to meet WCAG standards.

2

Labeled iconography and input labels have been used to ensure compatibility with screen readers.

3

Imagery was a big factor in the design. The use of alt-text on images will help make the app more accessible.
