General

1. The Tournament Director reserves the right to unilaterally add on, modify or substitute any of the terms and conditions below at any time as it deems fit without prior notice. If there is ambiguity in any of the provisions of the Terms and Conditions, the Tournament Director shall have sole discretion to interpret the ambiguous provision(s) as it deems fit.
2. If you cannot accept these Terms and Conditions or the risks associated with the Tournament, please do not proceed further with registration for this Tournament. By participating in the Tournament, you have read and understood the rules and regulations of the Tournament as released from time to time and agree to participate on the understanding that you must adhere to all the rules and regulations stipulated.
3. By participating in the Tournament, you acknowledge you have read and agreed to all the provisions in the Terms and Conditions for the Tournament. The Tournament Director reserves the right to refuse, disqualify or restrict you from participating in the Tournament and/or accessing the entitlements of the Tournament and claims thereto.

Key Dates and Venue

1. The tournament will take place on 22nd and 23rd August 2026 exclusively at Sterling, Sukhumvit 24, Bangkok – Bangkok's first fully integrated sport and wellness destination, offering 5 roofed, air-conditioned padel courts.

2. Getting there: BTS Skytrain Phrom Phong Station (E5), 15 min walk · 2–5 mins by car from EmSphere · 10–15 mins from Asok and Thonglor · on-site and valet parking available.

Tournament Registration

1. Registration for the Tournament will open on XXX and close on 15 August 2026, or earlier at the discretion of the Tournament Director.
2. The Tournament Director reserves the right to close registration early and/or move new registrations into a waitlist if Tournament slots are filled.
3. Registrants on the waitlist are not considered Participants until they have been directly contacted by the Organiser and/or its Agents with confirmation of the registration process.
4. All registrations must be completed through the designated registration platform.
5. Entry will only be confirmed upon full payment of tournament fees.
6. The Tournament Director reserves the right to reject or cancel any registration at its discretion.
7. The Tournament categories and available slots are as follows (tentative):
 - Bronze: 16 pairs in men and 12 pairs in women
 - Silver: 20 pairs in men and 10 pairs in women
 - Gold: 8 pairs in men and 4 pairs in women
8. It is Participants' sole responsibility to register in the correct category based on a truthful self-assessment of their playing ability, or risk forfeiture with no refund.
9. The Tournament Director reserves the right to reclassify players or teams where necessary to maintain fair competition.
10. The Participant warrants and agrees that all information provided by the registrant during the registration process for this Tournament shall be true, accurate, current, and complete information. If at any point of time, the Tournament Director has grounds to believe that such information provided by the Participant is untrue, inaccurate, obsolete, or incomplete, the Tournament Director may disqualify, suspend, or cancel the Participant's registration without any disputes nor refunds of the registration fee.
11. The Tournament Director shall not entertain nor be in any way responsible for any disputes, discrepancies or complaints arising from incomplete or inaccurate entry details by the Participant during the registration process.

Participation Fee, No-Refund Policy and Player Substitution

1. The Tournament registration fee is 1,700 THB per individual, or 3,400 THB per team.
2. Any cancellation notified more than 2 weeks before the event will be 100% refunded.
3. Any cancellation notified within 2 weeks of the event, but before pools are finalized and released will be 50% refunded. If you are able to find a suitable replacement approved by the Tournament Director, a 100% refund will be provided.
4. Any cancellation notified less than 1 week before the event, after pools have been finalized and released will be strictly not refunded.
5. All replacements are subject to approval by the Tournament Director to ensure suitability for the registered category and level.

Tournament Format

1. Match format, scoring system, and draw structure will be determined by the Tournament Director and may vary depending on the number of entries.
2. Late Arrival Policy applies across all categories: grace time of 5 minutes.

Knockout Stage	Quarterfinals (Male): superset to 9, golden point, tie-break at 8–8 to 7. Semifinals (Male/Female): superset to 9, 1 deuce / 1 golden, tie-break at 8–8 to 7. Finals: best of 3 sets, 1 deuce / 1 golden, tie-break at 6–6 to 7.

Knockout Stage	Quarterfinals (Male): superset to 9, golden point, tie-break at 8–8 to 7. Semifinals (Male/Female): superset to 9, 1 deuce / 1 golden, tie-break at 8–8 to 7. Finals: best of 3 sets, 1 deuce / 1 golden, tie-break at 6–6 to 7.
Consolation	Round 1 and Semifinal: 1 set to 6, golden point, tie-break at 5–5 to 7. Final: 1 set to 6, 1 deuce / 1 golden, tie-break at 5–5 to 7.

Group Stage	Male Gold: 8 pairs. Female Gold: 4 pairs. 1 set to 4 games, golden point, tie-break at 3–3 to 7.
Knockout Stage	Semifinals (Male/Female): superset to 9, 1 deuce / 1 golden, tie-break at 8–8 to 7. Finals: best of 3 sets, 1 deuce / 1 golden, tie-break at 6–6 to 7.
Consolation	Semifinal (Male): 1 set to 6, golden point, tie-break at 5–5 to 7. Final: 1 set to 6, 1 deuce / 1 golden, tie-break at 5–5 to 7.

Mixed / Invitational categories: not applicable for this event.

The Tournament Director reserves the right to amend the tournament format where necessary.

Forfeitures and Disqualifications

1. Players must be present and ready at least 15 minutes before their scheduled match time.
2. A grace period of 5 minutes may be granted at the discretion of the tournament committee.
3. Failure to appear thereafter may result in a walkover.

4. The Tournament Director may also disqualify Participants without compensation or refunds, prior and during the Tournament, on the following grounds:
 - The use of abusive, offensive, harassing, threatening or inappropriate language in any way, shape and form to the tournament committee and/or other Participants via personal interaction, email, mobile phone communications, and social media platforms, both before and during the Tournament;
 - Suspicion of cheating, doping or any means that Participants may employ to gain an unfair advantage over opponents, contrary to the spirit and rules of the sport of padel;
 - Unauthorised Participant substitutions and/or false declarations of personal identity and physical ability that directly or indirectly affect Participant's individual rankings and the categories that the Participant has registered for; and/or,
 - Unsportsmanlike behaviour as determined by the Tournament Director.

Participant Safety and Health

1. Whilst every reasonable precaution will be taken by the Tournament Director to ensure the Participants' safety, you agree that you are competing at your own risk. The Tournament Director shall not be held responsible or liable for any injury or death arising directly and/or indirectly from training in preparation for the Tournament and/or participation in the Tournament.
2. You are strongly encouraged to go for a medical check-up and/or consultation with your medical practitioner prior to registration and/or at any time from the date of registration until the date(s) of the Tournament to satisfy yourself of your physical and mental fitness to participate in the Tournament.
3. You are encouraged to have adequate personal accident and injury insurance coverage before participating in the Tournament.
4. While alcoholic beverages are available for purchase at the venue or locality of the Event Partners, Participants agree and warrant that they shall not drink and drive, nor consume alcohol if they are under the legal drinking age. If Participants choose to drink alcoholic beverages at the Tournament, it is the Participant's sole responsibility to arrange for a safe means of transportation such as a taxi, e-hailing, or ridesharing with a designated driver after the Tournament.
5. Participants are responsible for ensuring that they are physically and medically fit to participate. Participants with any medical condition that may be aggravated

by physical exertion should seek medical advice before participating and should not participate if advised against doing so by a medical professional.

6. The organizer, venue, sponsors, and partners shall not be held liable for any injury, loss, damage, or personal belongings during the tournament.

Force Majeure

1. The Organiser reserves the right to suspend, postpone, reschedule, relocate, modify or cancel any match or part of the event due to weather, rain, lightning, heat, venue conditions, safety concerns, operational issues, government restrictions, force majeure or any other circumstances beyond the Organiser's reasonable control.

Photography & Media

1. By participating, players consent to the use of photographs and videos taken during the tournament for promotional and marketing purposes.
2. The Participant agrees that the Organiser may film and/or photograph his/her likeness, and record his/her voice, conversation and sounds, including any performance, in connection with his/her appearance. The Participant understands that the Organiser will be the sole owner of the results and proceeds of such filming, photographing, and recording ("Materials") with the exclusive right, throughout the world, including copyright, to use and to license others to use all or any portion of the Materials, whether in connection with the Event or otherwise.
3. The Participant consents to the processing of his/her personal data by the Organiser in accordance with the Personal Data Protection Act B.E. 2562 (2019) of Thailand.
4. This Terms and Conditions, and all issues arising out of it shall be governed by the laws of Thailand and all disputes shall be referred exclusively to the courts of Thailand.
5. The Participant confirms he/she is at least eighteen (18) years of age and competent to contract in his/her own name.
6. If the Participant is under eighteen (18) years of age, he/she must obtain signed parental agreement in writing.

Final Decision

1. All decisions made by the tournament committee and referees are final.

2. The Tournament Director reserves the right to amend these Terms & Conditions without prior notice.
