## **TERMS & CONDITIONS**

### **TATLER PADEL SERIES 2026**

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#### **Event Terms & Conditions**

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##### **1. General**

1. By accepting an invitation and/or participating in the Tatler Padel Series - Singapore, each participant confirms that they have read, understood and agreed to these Event Terms & Conditions, the Tournament Terms & Conditions, the event rules, venue rules

and any instructions issued by the organiser, Tournament Director, referees, venue staff or appointed representatives.

2. The organiser and/or Tournament Director reserves the right to amend, add to, modify or substitute these Event Terms & Conditions, tournament format, schedule, categories, venue arrangements or operational requirements where necessary, including for safety, regulatory, operational or event delivery reasons.
3. If there is any ambiguity in these Event Terms & Conditions, the organiser and/or Tournament Director shall have the sole discretion to interpret and apply the relevant provision.
4. The organiser reserves the right to refuse, restrict, cancel or withdraw a participant's invitation or participation if the participant breaches these Event Terms & Conditions, the Tournament Terms & Conditions, venue rules, code of conduct or any reasonable instruction issued by the organiser, Tournament Director, referees or venue staff.

## **2. Invitation and Registration Confirmation**

1. Participation in the Tatler Padel Series – Singapore is by invitation only.
2. There is no registration fee payable by invited participants for participation in the Singapore event.
3. Participation is only confirmed once the invited participant has completed the required registration or confirmation process as communicated by the organiser.
4. Invitations are personal to the invited participant and may not be transferred, assigned, resold or substituted without prior written approval from the organiser.
5. The organiser reserves the right to cancel or withdraw any invitation, registration or participation at its discretion, including where participant information is incomplete, inaccurate, misleading or where the participant is deemed unsuitable for the registered category.

## **3. Participant Eligibility and Category Verification**

1. Participants are responsible for providing true, accurate, current and complete information during the registration or confirmation process.
2. Participants must register or participate in the correct category based on their playing level, eligibility and any category criteria communicated by the organiser.
3. The organiser and/or Tournament Director reserves the right to review, verify and reclassify players or teams where necessary to maintain fair competition.
4. If a participant is found to have provided false, inaccurate or misleading information, or is found to be competing in an unsuitable category, the organiser and/or Tournament Director may reclassify, suspend, disqualify or remove the participant from the event.

## **4. Substitution, Withdrawal and No-Show Policy**

1. As the Singapore event is invitational only and no registration fee is payable, no refunds will apply.
2. Any withdrawal must be communicated to the organiser as soon as possible.
3. Substitution or replacement of an invited participant is not permitted unless approved in writing by the organiser and/or Tournament Director.
4. All approved substitutions are subject to eligibility checks, category suitability, event capacity and operational feasibility.
5. Participants must arrive and be ready to play at the time communicated by the organiser. Failure to arrive on time may result in forfeiture, walkover or removal from the event schedule at the discretion of the Tournament Director.

## **5. Tournament Format, Schedule and Rules**

1. The tournament format, scoring system, draw structure, match schedule and progression criteria will be determined by the organiser and/or Tournament Director.
2. The organiser and/or Tournament Director reserves the right to amend the format, schedule, categories, match timings, rules or progression criteria where necessary, including due to number of entries, operational requirements, weather, safety or venue conditions.
3. All participants must follow the instructions of the Tournament Director, referees, court officials, venue staff and organiser representatives at all times.
4. The decision of the Tournament Director on all tournament-related matters, including eligibility, category placement, match rules, forfeits, disqualifications and progression, shall be final.

## **6. Venue Rules and Access**

1. The event will be held at Mandala Racquet Club, and all participants and guests must comply with Mandala Racquet Club's venue rules and policies.
2. All players must check in at reception and/or the event registration desk before accessing the courts or event areas.
3. Guest and spectator access may be subject to invitation, accreditation, wristband, capacity or venue restrictions. The organiser and venue reserve the right to refuse access where necessary.
4. Covered sports shoes must be worn on all courts. Sandals, slippers and barefoot play are not permitted.
5. Smoking is strictly prohibited on the premises.
6. Food is not permitted on the courts. Drinks are allowed only in sealed or closed bottles and food must be consumed only in designated areas.
7. Participants and guests must treat the courts, equipment and facilities with care. Any damage or maintenance issues should be reported to venue staff immediately.

8. External coaching sessions are not permitted unless expressly approved by the venue and organiser.
9. Dogs may be permitted in accordance with Mandala Racquet Club's venue rules, but must remain on a leash at all times and are not permitted in the pool.

## **7. Participant Code of Conduct**

1. Participants must conduct themselves in a respectful, sporting and appropriate manner at all times.
2. The organiser and/or Tournament Director may disqualify, remove or restrict a participant from the event without compensation if the participant engages in:
  - a. abusive, offensive, threatening, discriminatory or inappropriate language or behaviour;
  - b. harassment of organisers, venue staff, officials, players, guests or spectators;
  - c. cheating, deliberate misrepresentation, unfair play or conduct contrary to the spirit of the sport;
  - d. unauthorised substitution or false declaration of identity, eligibility or playing level;
  - e. damage to venue property, equipment or facilities;
  - f. failure to comply with venue rules, event rules or organiser instructions; or
  - g. any behaviour deemed unsportsmanlike or inappropriate by the Tournament Director.

## **8. Health, Safety and Liability Waiver**

1. Participants acknowledge that padel and sporting activity involve inherent risks, including injury, illness, accident or other physical harm.
2. By participating, each participant confirms that they are physically and medically fit to take part in the event and participate at their own risk.
3. Participants are encouraged to seek medical advice before participating if they have any health concerns or medical conditions.
4. Participants are responsible for ensuring they have adequate personal accident, medical or travel insurance coverage, where applicable.
5. The organiser, venue, sponsors, partners, employees, contractors and representatives shall not be liable for any injury, illness, death, loss, damage or expense suffered by a participant or guest, except where liability cannot be excluded under applicable law.
6. Participants must follow all health, safety, medical, emergency and venue instructions issued by the organiser, venue staff, medical personnel or event representatives.

## **9. Personal Belongings and Damage**

1. Participants and guests are responsible for their own personal belongings at all times.

2. The organiser, venue, sponsors and partners shall not be responsible for any loss, theft or damage to personal belongings.
3. Participants and guests may be held responsible for any damage caused by them to venue property, courts, equipment or facilities.

## **10. Weather, Cancellation and Force Majeure**

1. The organiser reserves the right to suspend, postpone, reschedule, relocate, modify or cancel any match or part of the event due to weather, rain, lightning, heat, venue conditions, safety concerns, operational issues, government restrictions, force majeure or any other circumstances beyond the organiser's reasonable control.
2. The organiser will make reasonable efforts to communicate any changes to participants, but shall not be liable for any costs, losses or expenses incurred as a result of any suspension, postponement, modification or cancellation.

## **11. Photography, Filming and Media Consent**

1. By attending or participating in the event, participants and guests consent to being photographed, filmed, recorded or otherwise captured during the event.
2. The organiser, sponsors, partners and appointed media representatives may use such photographs, videos, recordings, names, images, likenesses and event content for promotional, editorial, marketing, social media, commercial, archival and publicity purposes, without further approval or compensation.
3. Participants who do not wish to be photographed or filmed should inform the organiser in advance; however, the organiser cannot guarantee exclusion from all event photography or videography in public or shared event areas.

## **12. Data Protection and Privacy**

1. By registering for or participating in the event, participants consent to the collection, use, disclosure and processing of their personal data by the organiser, sponsors, partners, venues and appointed service providers for purposes related to the administration, operation, promotion and delivery of the event.
2. Such purposes may include registration, accreditation, communications, scheduling, category verification, event operations, safety, photography, marketing, reporting and post-event communications.
3. Personal data will be handled in accordance with applicable data protection laws and the organiser's privacy policies.
4. Participants may contact the organiser for any event-related personal data or privacy queries.

### **13. Final Decision**

1. All decisions made by the organiser, Tournament Director, referees and event officials in relation to the event shall be final.
2. The Tournament Director shall have final authority on all tournament matters, including but not limited to eligibility, categories, format, rules, scheduling, match results, forfeits, walkovers, disputes and disqualifications.
3. No appeals, claims or disputes shall be entertained once a final decision has been made by the
