• 10:30pm-Departure-

- o Pick-up at Bryant Park on 6th between 40th & 42nd Street.
- Bus starts loading at 10:30pm and departs at 10:45pm.
- o There will be a few rest stops on the way home. First stop will be approximately 25 minutes outside the City at a service plaza and it is recommended that you use this time to freshen up and change if needed. Then the next rest stops will be at driver's discretion but typically every 2 3 hours.
- Other information- You must be at the pick-up at 10:30pm for the final pick up, bus departs no later than 10:45pm. Reminder: meals, museums, shows or any other means of transportation are not included in the price of the ticket. You are free to do your own itinerary while in the City as long as you follow pickup and drop-off times and location. ❖ Other General Information- MEANS OF TRANSPORTATION AVAILABLE WHILE IN NYC

TIP: Download Google Maps to your cell phone. Google Maps is the easiest and the most reliable app to get directions of where you are going, either by walking, bus, subway or by car, (Taxi). This app will give you the directions of where you going and which subway line to use.

- 1. **UBER** (HIGHLY RECOMMENDED)
 - -How to use UBER-
 - Download UBER app to your cell phone. First, tap to set your pickup location. Request your ride and a driver will accept. Enter the address or name of your destination. After pickup, we show the driver where you're going and will show you the route and ETA.
- 2. MTA NYC Subway & Bus Service (Cheapest & Quickest way to travel around the City)
 - -How to use the Subway-
 - At most Subway Stations you can purchase a \$1 Metro Card valid for subway and MTA Bus. Cost: \$2.75 for one trip. Express buses cost \$6.75 (Cost could be subject to change)
- 3. **Double Decker Grey Line Bus services.** (Where you hop on and off.)
 - -How to use the Double Decker City Tour Bus-
 - Address: 1430 Broadway, New York, NY 10018 Phone: (212) 397-2620 to purchase a ticket, either go to the Grey Line Visitor Station on 8th Ave between 47th 48th streets. Or purchase the ticket online, www.newyorksightseeing.com/visitor-centers
- 4. Yellow Cab NYC Taxi service, (Convenience)
 - Typically, no matter where you are throughout NYC there's always a Yellow Cab that you can wave down. *NOTE- Yellow Cab is the only service in the City that is licensed to work.
