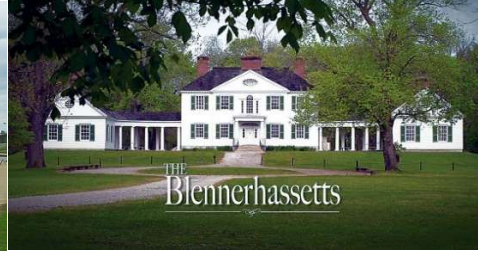




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AHT- Tour of Blennerhassett Island

TRIP ITINERARY

Wednesday September 23rd, 2026

- **7:00am 1st Pick-up-**
 - Will meet at the Wal-Mart parking near the fuel station
 - Bus starts loading at 7:00am and departs at 7:15am
 - **Address: 32 Tygart Valley Mall, Fairmont, WV 26554**
- **7:45am 2nd Pick-up-**
 - Will meet at the Kohl's parking lot near the tree line
 - Bus starts loading at 7:45am and departs at 8:00am
 - **Address: 330 Emily Dr. Clarksburg, WV 26301**
- **9:30am Blennerhassett Museum-**
 - The Blennerhassett Museum of Regional History is a three-story museum focused on the history of the Blennerhassett family and the history of the Mid-Ohio Valley region. Peruse local artifacts and great background on Harman and Margaret Blennerhassett before visiting the Island. Also contains Stahl collection, a vast assortment of artifacts found on the island from Native American arrow heads to tools to clothes. **included**
- **11:00am Ferry to Blennerhassett Island-**
 - We will board the Island Belle Ferry from Point Park in Parkersburg WV, the 19th century-style riverboat and ride across the Ohio River to Blennerhassett Island. **included**
- **Blennerhassett Island-**
 - Once on the Island, we will have a guided tour of mansion and enjoy a horse-drawn carriage ride around the Island. **included**
 - Blennerhassett Island is a gem. Visiting the island is 'a must see' attraction in West Virginia. Located on a small island in the Ohio River, Blennerhassett Island Historical State Park features a Palladian mansion visited by 40,000 people each year. The mansion was originally built by Harman Blennerhassett and his wife Margaret, who were wealthy Irish immigrants, in 1800.

- **3:00pm Guided Tour-**
 - Will have a guided tour of Julia-Ann Square Historic District is the largest and oldest historic district in West Virginia and was important center in WV early history. Homeowners were comprised of leaders from the community including banker, businessmen, professionals and political figures who had the financial means to construct the best houses of that time. Comprised of approximately 126 homes, the district's structures are the Second Empire, 19 century eclectic and Queen Ann styles dating from 1850 to 1910. Guided tour included / Gratuity not included
