Trip Itinerary:

- **7:00 am- 1st Pick-up:**
 - We will meet at Kohl's parking lot at 7:00am & depart by 7:15am
 - **Address: 330 Emily Dr, Clarksburg, WV 26301**
- **7:45 am- 2nd Pick-up:**
 - We will meet at the Walmart parking lot near Mariachis restaurant at 7:45am & depart by 8:15am.
 - **Address: 75 Retail Cir #2083, Morgantown, WV 26508**
- **9:30 am- Fallingwater House and Grounds:**
 - Guided tour of the Fallingwater House Interior and free time to walk the grounds and gift shop.
 - Fallingwater is inscribed as one of 24 UNESCO World Heritage sites in the U.S. and is listed along attractions including the Pyramids of Egypt, the Great Wall of China and the Taj Mahal.
 - This house designed by the architect Frank Lloyd Wright in 1939 in the Laurel Highlands of southwest PA. It blends seamlessly with the landscape and waterfall, fully expressing Wright's concept of "organic architecture." Fallingwater seemingly suspends in mid-air above the shimmering cascade, creating the dramatically elegant home. Tour Fallingwater and experience the profound architectural genius' work yourself! **Tour Included**
 - Lunch at Fallingwater Café: not included
 - **12:30 pm- Departure:** Load the bus after lunch to travel to Frank Lloyd Wright's Kentuck Knob
- **1:00 pm – Frank Lloyd Wright's Kentuck Knob:**
 - Guided Tour of Kentuck Knob, which is a striking expression of Wright's Usonian vision – built from native sandstone and North Carolina cypress, it feels at one with its surroundings. Back patio, with views of the Youghiogheny River Forge and Laurel Highlands complete the setting. At 2,050 feet above sea level, Kentuck Knob sits just below the mountain's crest, appearing as a natural extension of the hill itself. Expanses of glass and cantilevered overhangs effortlessly blur the line between interior and landscape. **Tour included**
- **4:00 pm Stone House Restaurant:**
 - The Stone House Restaurant located in Pennsylvania's scenic Laurel Mountains. First opened its doors in 1822 to waggoners and travelers seeking renewed health in the waters of nearby Fayette Springs. Ever since those early days, the Stone House has been regarded as a charming getaway for fine dining and good times in a peaceful mountain setting.
