



The route

We welcome you on board the Haugesund City Train at the cruise terminal. The train runs at a leisurely pace from Risøya and over Risøy-bridge, where you will have nice view over "Karmsundet." After this, we head for Hasseløy, where we pass white houses and narrow alleyways. Hasseløy played a central role when herring became a staple in Haugesund in the 19th century.

On our way back over Hasseløy bridge, you can look straight over to the statue of the Viking King; Harald Fairhair. The region has a rich Viking history. We make a short stop at "Haraldshaugen," a memorial monument built for the Battle of Hafsfjord in 872, where Harald Fairhair gathered Norway into one kingdom. From Haraldshaugen, the train heads south towards the city center.

Today, Haugesund is a modern town that deals in fishing, shipping and oil-related industries. Continuing through Haugesund, we see ornate houses built in "Jugendstil," or "Art Nouveau" style. We pass a house on Strandgata 92, which stands out as a piece of, almost, decorated jewelry.

The train passes through areas where newly rich Haugesunders built magnificent houses financed by fish and freight during World War I. Once we get back to the city center, we will view the city's Italian inspired town hall. It was named Norway's finest town hall in 2010. Our journey continues to the Church of Our Savior, where we make a stop and it is possible to disembark and explore the city centre on your own. The city train returns to the cruise terminal where our journey ends.
