

URC26 Signing Ceremonies Policy

As an international, high-level conference aiming to deliver impact towards Ukraine's reconstruction and recovery, URC26 also acts as a platform for attending parties to sign chosen documents and declarations.

There are two stages available for signing ceremonies during URC26: at AmberExpo (for political declarations) and at the Polsat Stadium (for business declarations). The timeslots allotted to each signing ceremony are 15 minutes long.

Parties wishing to use a stage for their signing ceremony at URC26 are required to follow the following regulations:

1. To declare the intention of a signing ceremony and be granted a timeslot, date, and stage with the possibility of media presence, at least one of the parties responsible for the signing ceremony needs to fill out the [Signing Ceremony Declaration Form](#).
2. The submission of the form does not automatically guarantee a timeslot. Confirmations of allocated timeslots and stages will be delivered via email.
3. Incomplete submissions will automatically be rejected.
4. Shall a submission be rejected due to lack of space, the organizers still encourage booking a bilateral room via the URC26 app to conduct the signing.
