

SOUTH AFRICA

KENYA

BOTSWANA



Chobe National Park has the highest concentration of elephants in Africa, with game drives and river cruises revealing rich wildlife. The Kalahari Desert provides a contrasting safari experience with black-maned lions, meerkats, and gemsbok.



Victoria Falls, one of the world's largest and most famous waterfalls, is only a 2-hour drive across the Botswana-Zimbabwe border from Chobe; an excellent day trip.

📍 Spot Rare Species in Central Kalahari Game Reserve

Discover the vast landscapes of the Kalahari Desert, home to unique wildlife such as the black-maned Kalahari lions, meerkats, and gemsbok.

📍 Chopper Over the Delta

A scenic helicopter flight over the Okavango Delta is the best way to appreciate this amazing natural phenomenon.






