SUMMARY 2025

ANOTHER YEAR OF FLIPPING THE DISABILITY NARRATIVE

2025 was our most impactful year to date. In just twelve months, 2Gether-International supported more than 700 entrepreneurs, adding it to a total of 1300 historically with disabilities across 40+ countries, delivering over 500 hours of training and mentorship and enabling access to \$500,000+ in Non-Deluted Capital funding.

Grounded in our belief that disability is a competitive advantage, not a limitation, we continued to challenge traditional narratives around entrepreneurship. This year also marked our expansion into new geographies, including Latin America, strengthening a global ecosystem that centers innovation, resilience, and lived experience as drivers of scalable impact.
