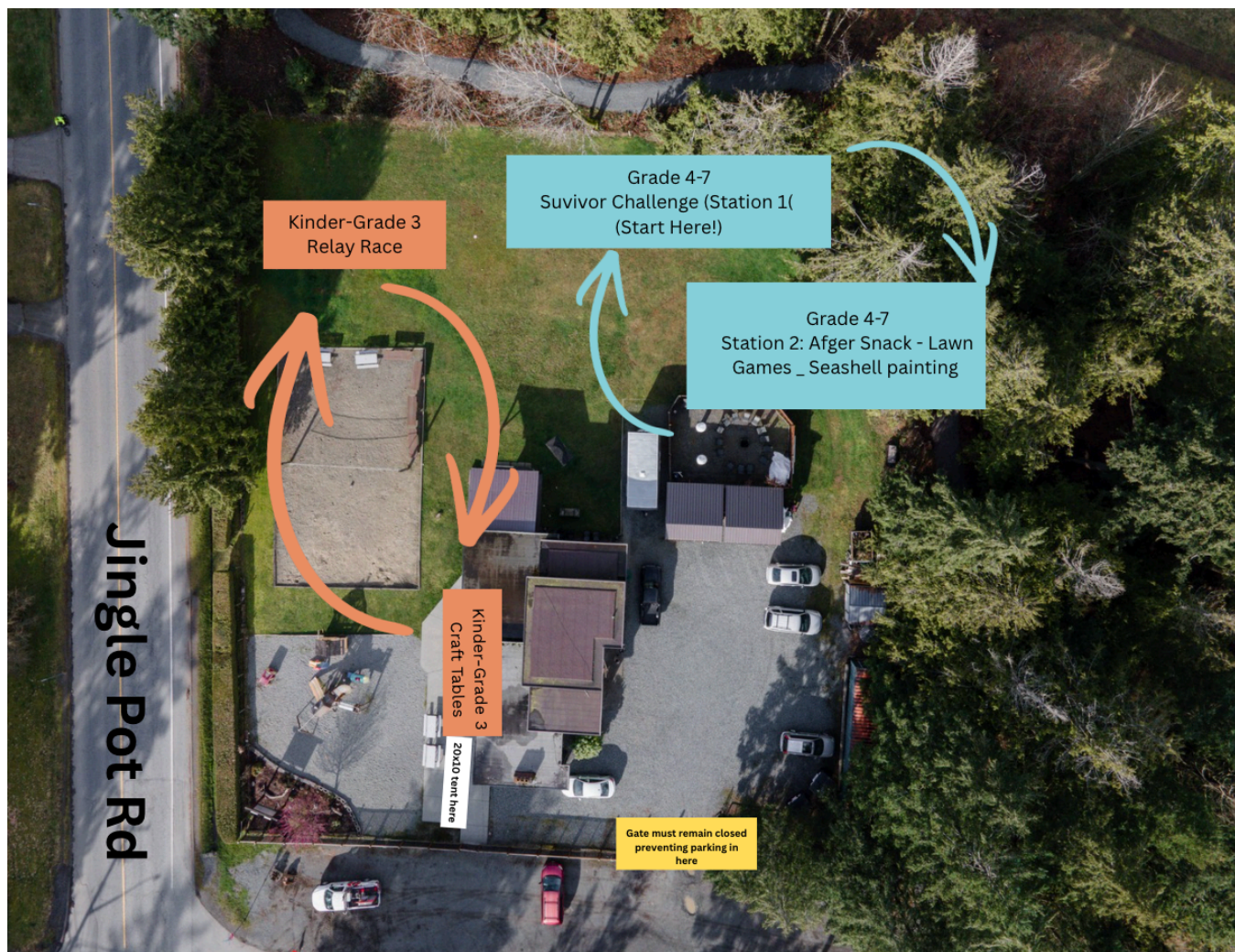
General Info:

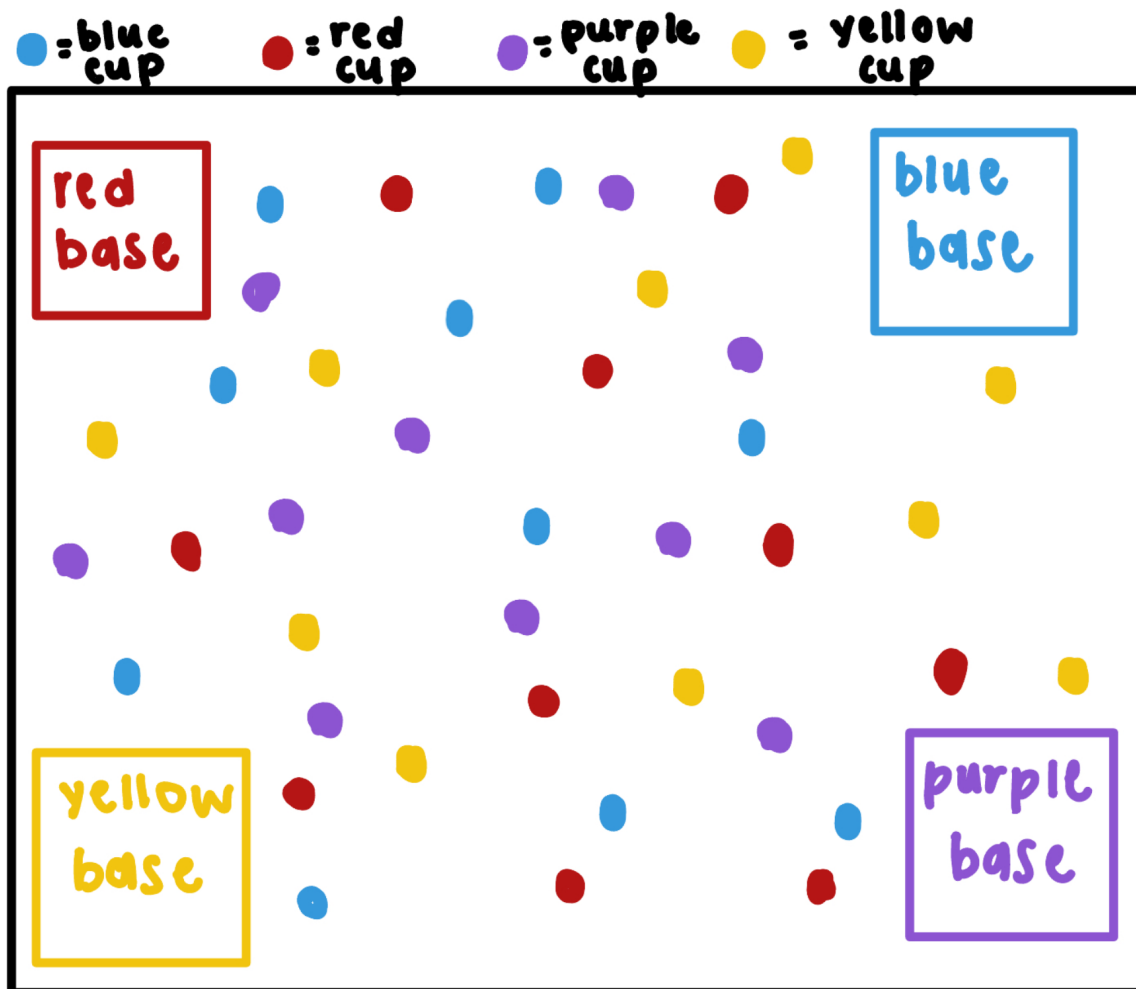

Stations:

Station 1: Survivor Challenge (Start here!)

- **Location:** Grade 4-7 Upper Right of field (behind the small fenced in area/offices)
 - **Set Up:** Place 40 cups in the field scattered everywhere, mark each teams base in the 4 corners of the field

Part 1:

Game Rules:

- 4 teams! Each team will be a color of cups (red, blue, purple or yellow)
 1. Each team has to collect all 10 of their colors cups. Do not take another teams cups.
 2. You must be blindfolded if you are the teammate retrieving a cup.
 3. You can switch blindfolded players at any time.
 4. Only one teammate is allowed to be off the base at a time.
 5. Each team can only grab one cup at a time and take it back to their base before grabbing another cup.

6. The other teammates still at the base should be guiding teammate to their colored cups with only their voices.

Once the team gets all 10 cups from the field, they may move on to part 2



Part 2

Setup: Each team will get a rubber cup holder with strings attached.

Rules:

1. Each team must use the cup tool to stack their cups into a pyramid.
2. They may not use their hands or bodies in anyway to help stack. [Aktivitäten zum teamaufbau | Teamwork spiele, Camping-spiele, Schule](#)

First team to stack their cups in a pyramid wins the challenge!

Stations:

Station 2: 20 Minute Garden Games (after snack time!)

- **Location:** See Map, there are allocated spots throughout the Junction playground: Corn hole, Connect 4, Giant Jenga, Volleyball, Soccer, Shell painting (for those who want to do a craft!)
 - Shell Painting can be set up on the deck behind the Junction. The kids can color the seashells with the markers provided!
 - This time is pretty self explanatory, please ensure you walk around and keep an eye out, as the groups will be dispersed throughout the lawn.
