Solo Variation Fee

- Early Bird (by Sept 1st, 2025): \$125
- · Regular (after Sept 1st, 2025): \$135
- · Late (after Oct 1st): \$145

Group Fees

- · Small Ensemble (4 dancers) \$70 per dancer, per entry
- · Large Ensembles (5+ members) \$60 per dancer, per entry

Rehearsals:

- TADA dancers can participate in 1) a group contemporary piece, *and/or* 2) a solo variation.
- Solo classical ballet variations will be invitation only

GROUP PIECE Rehearsals: Rehearsals for the YAGP group piece will be held Friday evenings during regular class time.

SOLOISTS: Rehearsals for soloists will be held outside of the Friday Pre-Pro class time.

- Rehearsals for soloists will require at least two (2) 30-minute rehearsals a week for 8-12 weeks.
- Available times will likely include: Tuesdays 7:30-8:30p, Wednesday 4:45-5:45, Thursdays 4-5pm, and Fridays 6:30-8:30pm.
- Soloist private rehearsals will incur a \$25 charge per 30-minute rehearsal.
