

Privacy Policy – International Corporate Art

1. Introduction

This Privacy Policy explains how International Corporate Art processes personal data in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and applicable Norwegian data protection legislation.

2. Data Controller

International Corporate Art is the data controller responsible for the processing of personal data described in this policy.

3. Personal Data We Process

We may process personal data such as name, email address, telephone number, company affiliation, and other information necessary to provide our services, respond to inquiries, or fulfil contractual obligations.

4. Purpose and Legal Basis

Personal data is processed for purposes including customer administration, contract performance, communication, legal compliance, and legitimate business interests.

The legal basis for processing is GDPR Article 6 (1) (b), (c), and (f).

Personal data is retained only for as long as necessary to fulfil the purpose of processing or to comply with statutory obligations.

6. Data Sharing

Personal data is not shared with third parties unless required by law or necessary for service delivery under a data processing agreement.

7. Information Security

We implement appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect personal data against unauthorised access, loss, or misuse.

8. Your Rights

You have the right to access, rectify, erase, restrict, or object to the processing of your personal data, as well as the right to data portability, in accordance with GDPR.
