


Sonnymoon For Two is a 12-bar blues with a repeating motific melody that doesn't change to match the chords. This was originally played with a medium-swing feel.





Sonnymoon for Two (Part 2 - harmony)




On Cue: Background for solos. Tenor play upper notes. Others play lower notes.



Shout chorus. Play after solos (optional). Tenor play upper octave. Others play lower octave.




Useful scales: C Blues Scale






Sonnymoon for Two (Part 2 - harmony)





• Backing Track - No Introduction


