

Residence Hall Guide

Thank you for choosing to stay in our Champion Christian College Dormitory! We have recently remodeled and updated our dormitory facility in hopes of enhancing our students' safety and comfort.

What's Included

The following items are provided by Champion:

- 2 Bottom bunk beds; one for you and one for your roommate
(Some rooms may include a top bunk bed)
- 2 Wardrobes; one for you and one for your roommate
(Some rooms may include an extra wardrobe)
- Ceiling fan
- Mattress
(You may bring your own twin-size mattress)
- AC/Heating unit
- Built-In Shelving
- Dual sinks
- Mirror
- Toilet
- Shower

If by chance you decide that you wish to have furniture removed from your room you must receive permission through the student services office. **YOU MAY NOT MOVE CAMPUS FURNITURE INTO OR OUT OF YOUR DORM ROOM WITHOUT PERMISSION.** Doing so will result in fines or other penalties.

What to Bring

- Refrigerator (**Must not exceed 4.5 cubic feet**)
- Microwave
- Trash Can
- Curtains for a single window (48" x 64")
- Electronics (laptop, tables, game console, etc.)
- Personal mementos
- Tacs and/or command hooks for decor
- Linens and towels (standard twin-size beds)
- Cleaning supplies
- Medicine, toiletries, and first aid supplies
- LED light strips (These are allowed. However, we ask that you use wall tacks instead of the sticky backing provided OR attach them to the concrete walls. When the sticky backing is used and the lights are removed, the paint is torn off the walls. If this happens, you will incur a **damage fee starting at \$100**)

- Preparing for college can be overwhelming and the list of items you may need or want to bring to college can be quite extensive. However, keep in mind a few helpful tips: You don't need to bring everything at once. You can always pick up additional items during visits home. Additionally, Amazon offers same-day delivery, Hot Springs has four Walmart locations, and Target is just 30 minutes away!

Prohibited Items:

- Open element appliances (toasters, hot plates, broilers, open coil space heaters, grills)
- Air Fryers
- Halogen lights
- Candles
- Dart boards that could puncture the walls
- Personal Air Conditioners
- Firearms, alcohol, marijuana in all forms, and tobacco.
- Although many of our students are of legal age to purchase and use nicotine vape pens and/or cigarettes, the use of these products is **PROHIBITED** at any Champion event and/or facility including but not limited to, sports facilities, parking lots, off campus student life events, etc.
- Any items or materials prohibited by law or not in accordance with the Christian atmosphere of CCC (This includes but is not limited to offensive decor in room and on vehicles)
- Pets or other animals
- Drilling, hammering, or any construction into the walls is prohibited and will result in a fine based upon the damage.

Men are not permitted on the women's hall floor and women are not permitted on the men's hall floor.

Guidelines

Here are some other guidelines to remember during your stay here in our Champion Dormitory:

- Curfew is at 11:00pm (Sunday-Thursday) and 12am (Friday-Saturday).
- A *Student Visitor Request Form* must be filled out for a guest to visit the student dormitory.

- A “**guest**” is defined as a person at least 18 years of age with a picture ID (*drivers license, State ID, etc.*), and is not enrolled into the College or is an enrolled Champion Christian College student that lives off campus.
- A **maximum** of **TWO** guests are allowed per day. Visiting days and hours for guests are Tuesdays through Saturdays (no guests allowed on Sunday’s and Monday’s) and anytime between 3pm and exit by 10:30pm.
- Guests and off campus students must be out of the dormitory by 10:30pm.
- Notify your RA for any issues you may have with your room or roommate. If necessary they will bring the issue to the Director of Student Life. If a problem still occurs, the Vice President of Student Services will step in to provide guidance to the situation.
- **Work Request forms** for room repairs are located under “*Student Resources*” on Champion.edu.
- Evacuation procedures are posted on the wall, toward the entrance of your specific dorm hall.
- If you are staying overnight off campus, you must sign out through the student services office. The request form is located under “*Student Resources*” on Champion.edu.
- Your room is expected to be ready for *possible* inspection every Wednesday at 9:00 a.m. (*Random dorm inspections may occur if necessary.*)
- Your assigned lounge area, hallway, and laundry room are expected to be cleaned every week. Your assigned RA will provide your dorm floor a cleaning list and schedule. This is to be completed as a group.
- **TRASH VALET SERVICE.** Trash will be picked up every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday between 8am and 10am. Trash should be placed outside your dorm door, in a bag, tied, and closed no later than 8am for pick up. Any large boxes should be broken/smashed down as much as possible. If you do not properly seal your trash or you are taking advantage of the pick up system, you will receive a violation fee and risk losing trash service for that semester. Also, should a student services representative find excessive or idle trash in your room, you will receive a fine starting at \$25 for your first offense. Proper trash removal is a matter of hygiene that affects all those residing on your dorm floor. Please be mindful and do your part to keep our facilities clean.
