Arkansas Academic Challenge+ Scholarship

Arkansas Academic Challenge + Scholarship is an additional amount added to the award amount once a student is approved for the Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship. This amount is based on FAFSA results and student academic year; the scholarship range is from \$500-\$3,000 in addition to the award amount listed above with the maximum amount eligible per year being \$5,000.

Arkansas Teacher Academy Scholarship

The <u>Arkansas Teacher Academy Scholarship</u> is a program that offers aspiring teachers up to \$6,000 for tuition and program fees each semester for undergraduate studies. For every year a student receives funding, the student is required to teach in an Arkansas public school.

Requirements: Within one year of completion, Academy attendees must teach in an Arkansas public school for each year of funding received.
