- Draft 2026 Budget
 - SCBA options Contractors coming in to demo different units.
 Expecting that EFD will pay for upon purchase and not finance. Hope to have final number by mid-August. Ordering SCBAs in October for delivery in early 2026.
 - Push third 3rd Battalion Chief to 2027 and adding fencing consortium fee, shifting from 100% PD to 50/50 PD and Fire.
 - Paid FMLA Budgeting for in 2026.

- b. Response 2 min enroute; 5 min on-scene; 6-8 ff per call
- c. Staffing expecting several FF to retire next year; Have six on list and will bring on in April 2026. Scott Spinks has taken over all training as of July 1.
