No one can come to the Father except through me.'

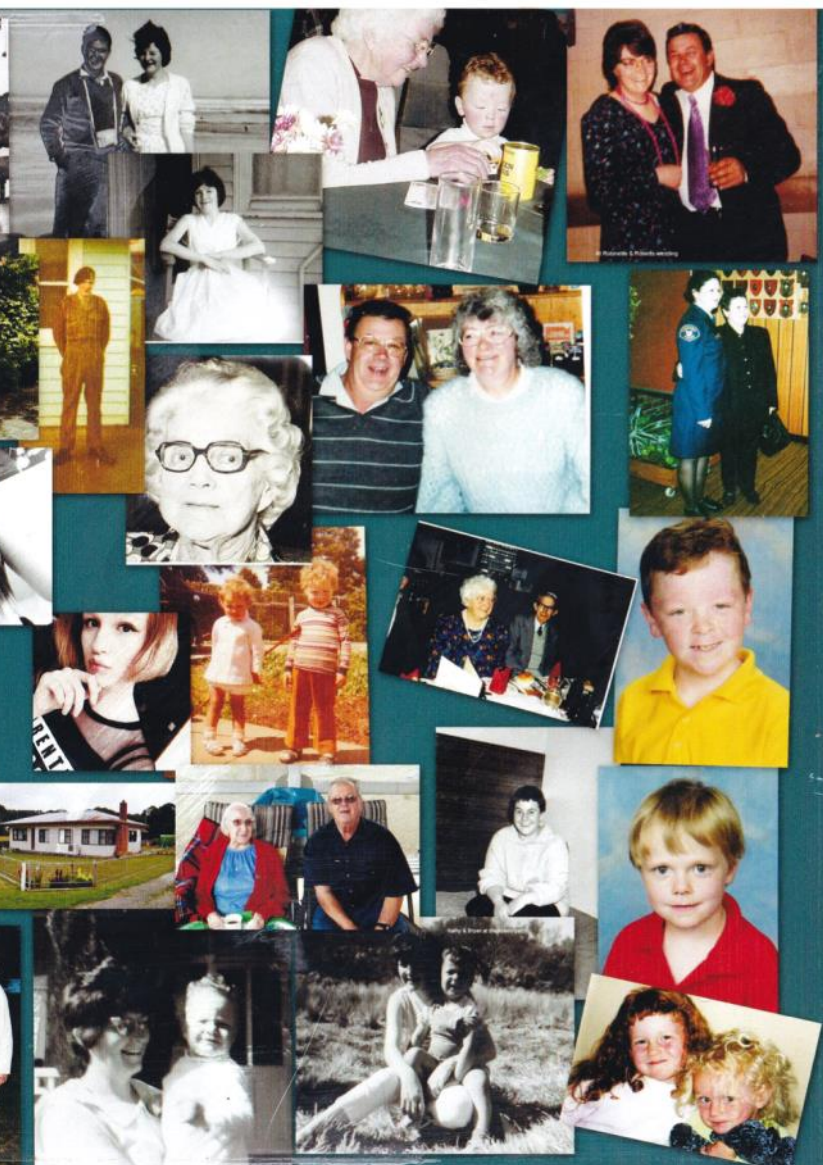
