I just can't comprehend.

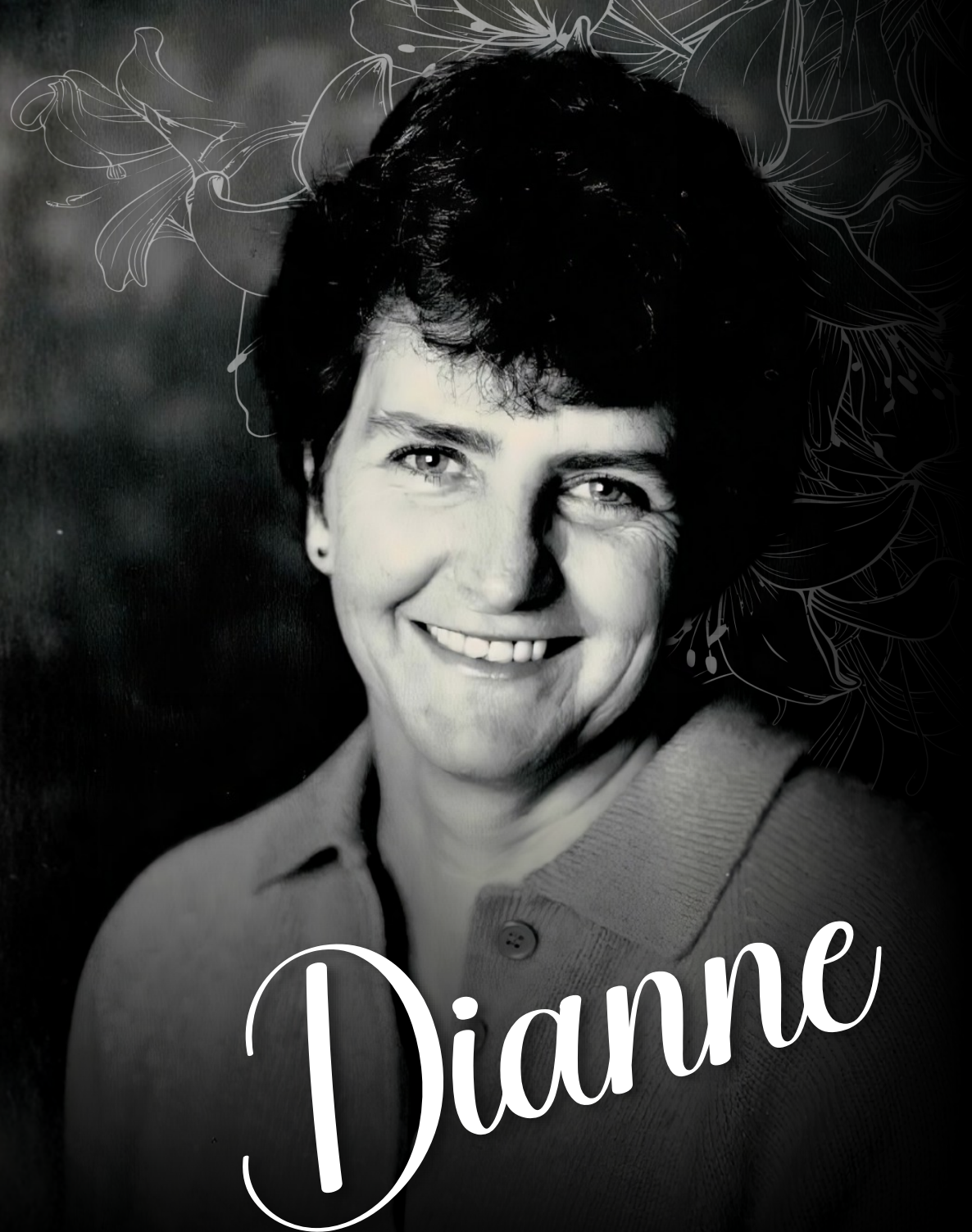
I see now it was love, Mum,
