Priest: Eternal rest grant unto him, O' Lord.

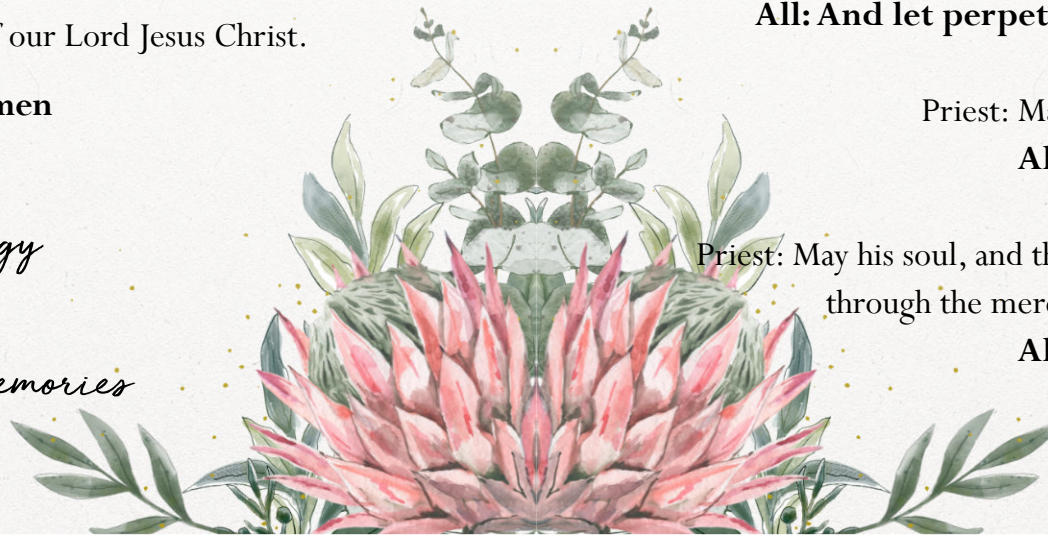

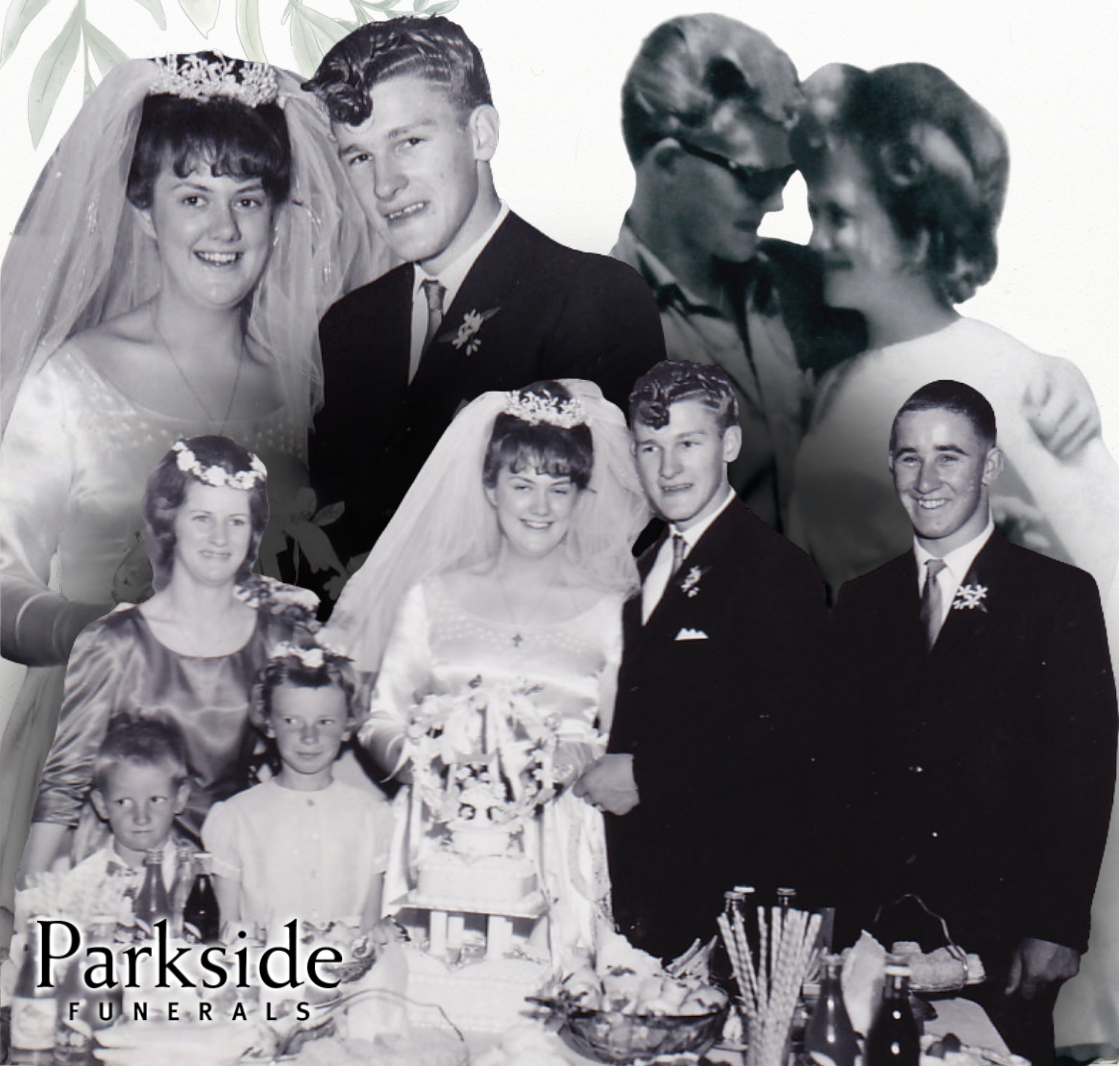
