You anoint my head with oil; My cup runs over.

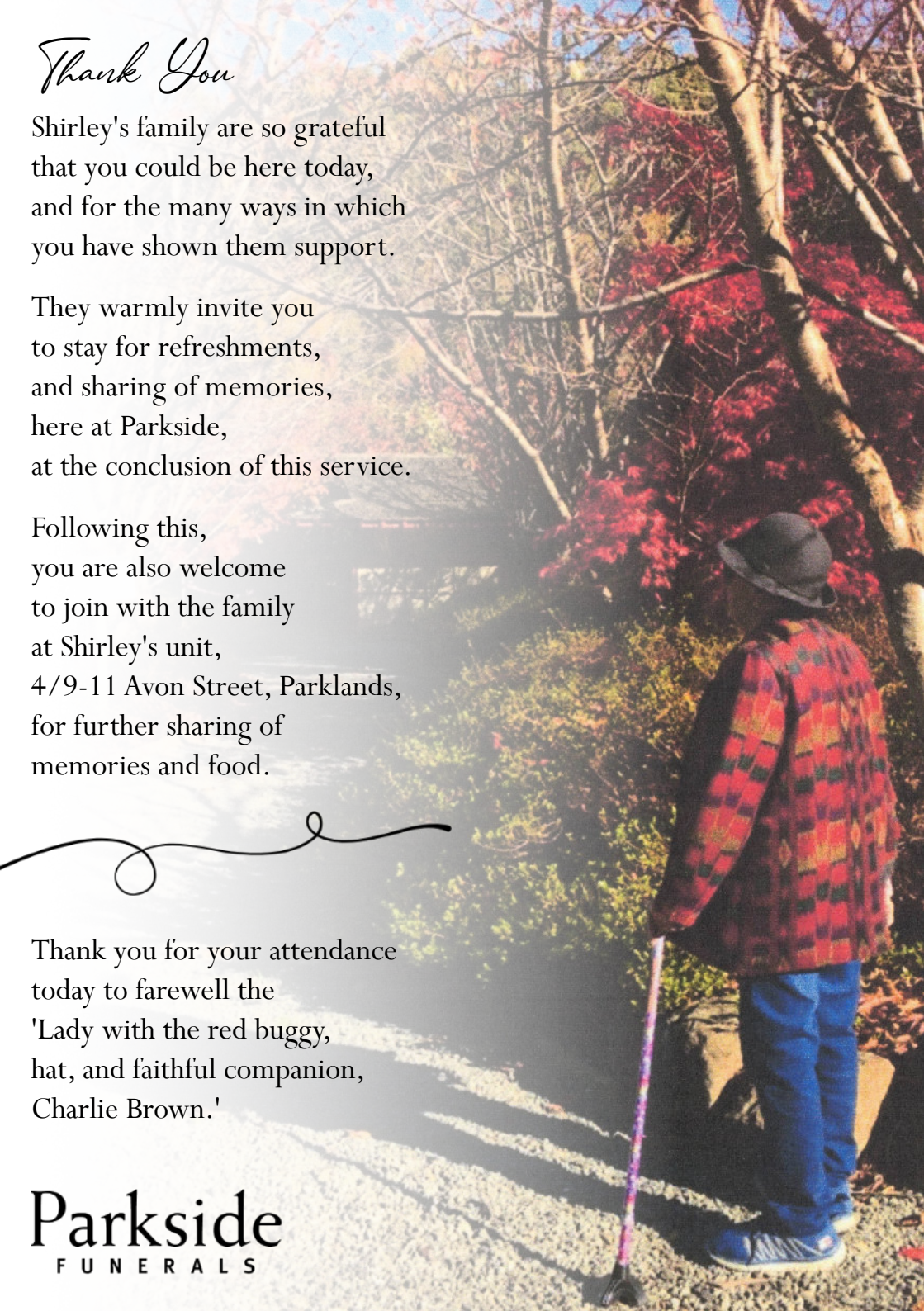
Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me
