There Is A Green Hill Far Away

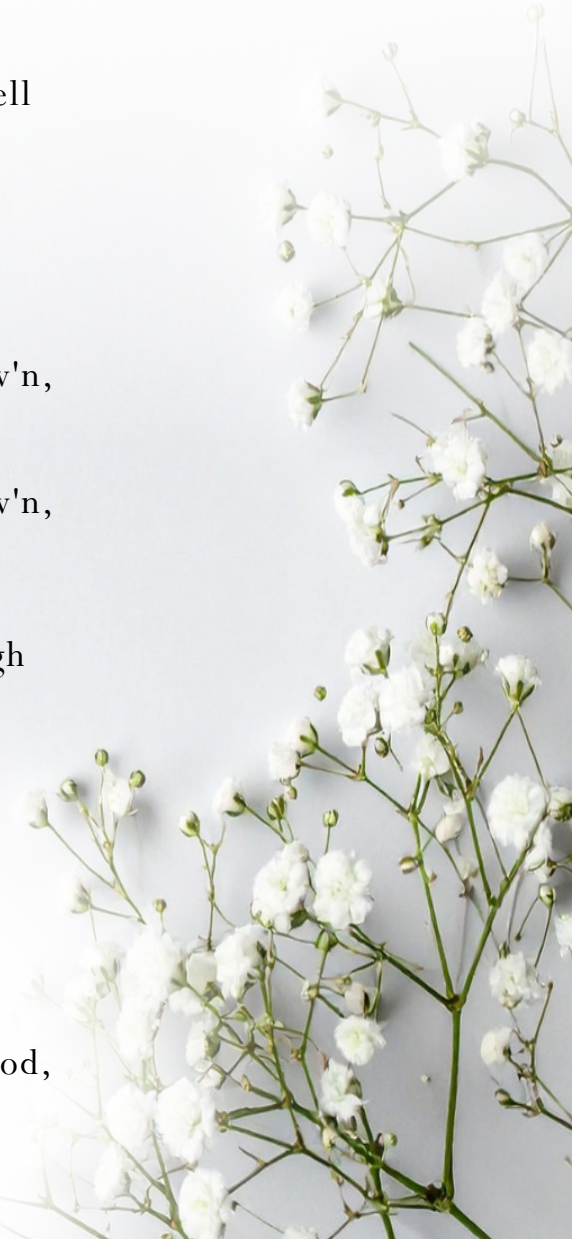
There is a green hill far away,

with these words.

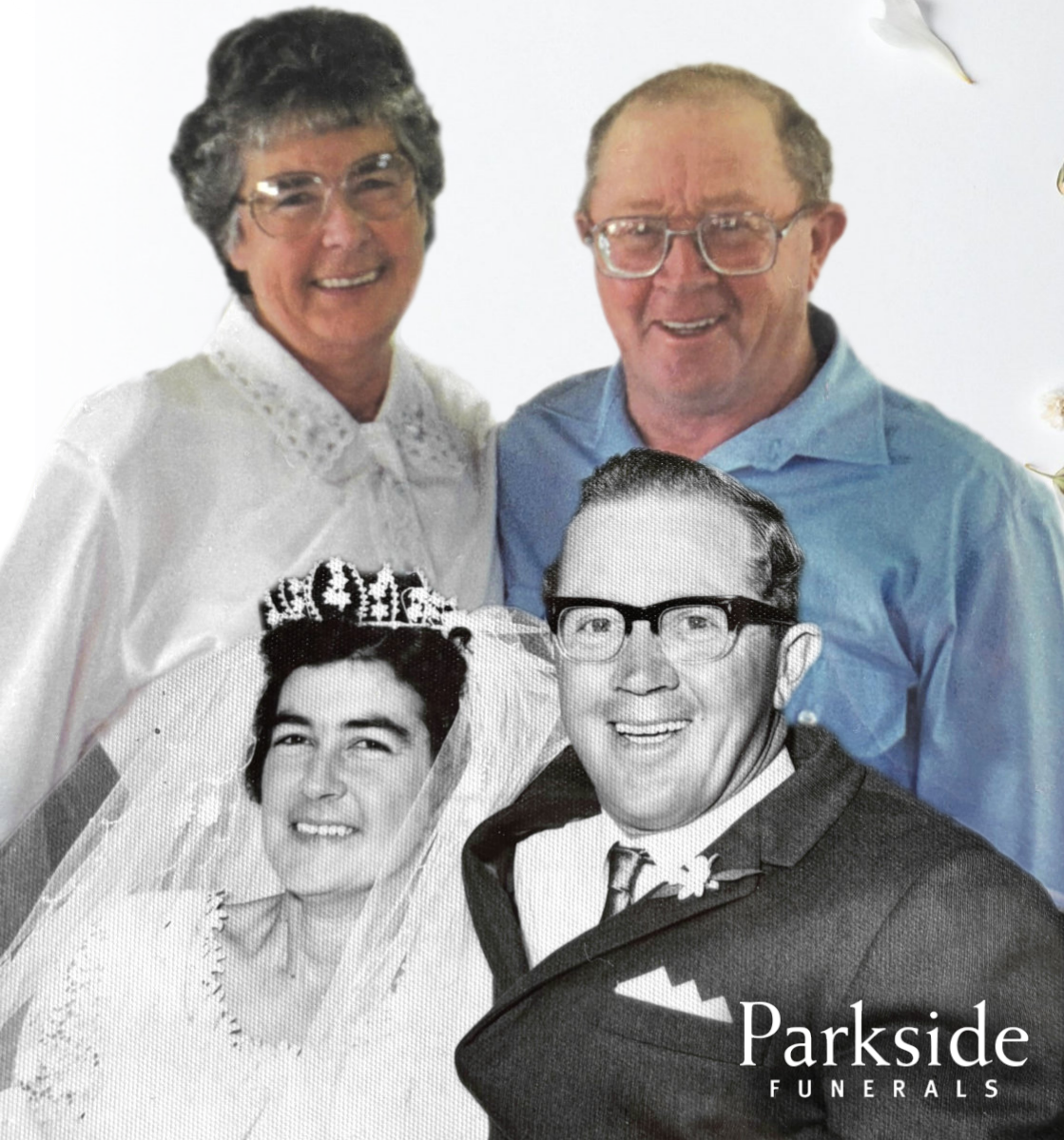
