

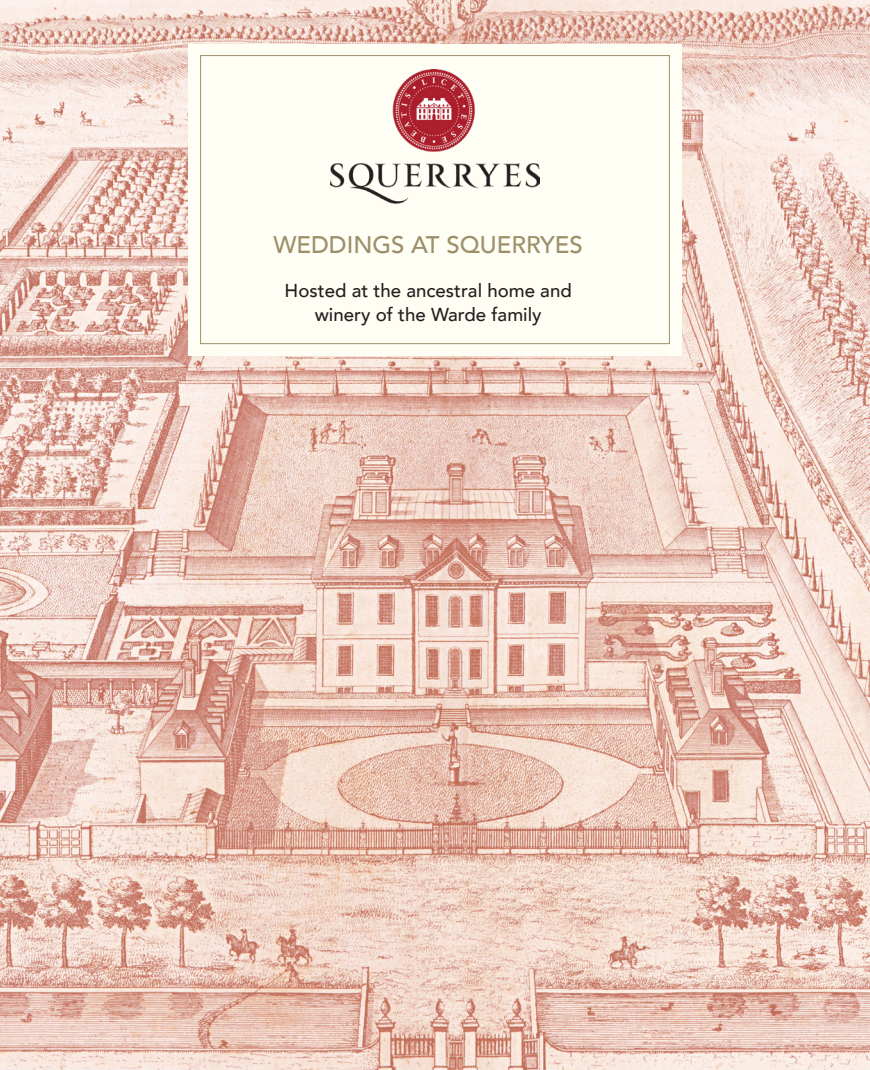

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CIVIL CEREMONIES AT SQUERRYES COURT

Just on the outskirts of Westerham, Squerrys Court is a 17th century grade I listed building surrounded by extensive gardens and parkland. It has far reaching views across the Kent countryside yet is within easy reach of London and local train stations.

Arriving at Squerrys Court along the sweeping driveway, visitors first glimpse the magnificent front façade of the house with the lake opposite. Civil ceremonies are licensed to take place in the Main Hall, a large airy space adorned with portraits of the Warde family's ancestors and a grand fireplace. After your civil ceremony, hospitality packages are available if you decide to stay for photographs around the grounds.
