**Course Description**

This course of study is divided into several areas of concentration. Students enrolled in this course of study must complete 600 hours before graduation eligibility is granted. To be eligible for graduation students must complete 600 hours of theory and practical training, complete all assignments, and pass all theory and practical exams as well as exit exams. Tests are scheduled weekly and cover chapters listed on the calendar. Theory classes are taught by lectures, audio/visual aids, group demonstration, guest speakers, and other techniques catered to each students' method of learning.

**Teaching Methods**

Classroom Lectures and Demonstratives (Theory), Laboratory Instructions and Supervision Field Trips, Evaluation and Advising, Academic Classes in Each Subject, Clinic Operations.

Esthetic Excellence Academy is equipped with Audio-visual training aids, tapes, and DVDs; however, they do not replace the classroom instructor, only assist by improving on the lesson to be learned.
