

## **2025 MASTER ELECTROLYSIS PROGRAM**

**FULL-TIME 6 MONTHS 24 WEEKS 93 DAYS 26 HOURS 8:30 AM – 4:00 PM**

### **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

This course of study is divided into several areas of concentration. Students enrolled in this course of study must complete 600 hours before graduation eligibility is granted. To be eligible for graduation students must complete 600 hours of theory and practical training, complete all assignments, meet model requirements, and pass all theory and practical exams as well as exit exams. Tests are scheduled weekly and cover chapters listed on the calendar. Theory classes are taught by lecture, audio/visual aids, group demonstration, guest speakers, and other techniques catered to each students' method of learning.

### **DESCRIPTION**

The Electrology Program is the ideal program for any applicant wishing to become a Licensed Electrologist and has the schedule availability to attend onsite. This program is the elite program as students in training are subject to a multitude of daily education and hands on demonstration. Students who need more hands-on instruction, this program is for you! Each day theory will be instructed for 1 hour and clinicals will follow for the remainder of the day. Students will receive an extensive amount of training. Prior to being awarded a Certificate of Completion, students must service a total of 30 paying models in which the student is responsible for booking. Students who have not completed 30 paying models by their scheduled graduation date will be charged \$250.00 per week in overtime charges until said student has reached all graduation requirements.

### **TEACHING METHODS**

Classroom Lectures and Demonstratives (Theory), Laboratory Instructions and Supervision Field Trips, Evaluation and Advising, Academic Classes in Each Subject, Clinic Operations. Esthetic Excellence Academy is equipped with Audio-visual training aids, tapes, and DVDs; however, they do not replace the classroom instructor, only assist by improving on the lesson to be learned.
