KIDS' LESSON

One Sunday afternoon my nephew came walking into the house soaking wet in his church clothes. We all asked, "What happened?" My nephew blamed his sister, "She sprayed me with those hose!" We asked, "Why did she do that?" And he said, "I don't know! Maybe because I sprayed her?!?"

We all know water isn't always a good thing. Yes, water can make us clean and that's good but water can also be this thing we use to get back at each other, to punish each other. Sometimes water is scary. If you don't know how to swim you have to stay away from a pool. Big waves at the ocean can wash over us.

The Old Testament prophet, Nahum, says God's judgment is like a flood. And Nahum says God's judgment is coming for the powerful kingdom of Assyria for their sin and there is nothing they can do to stop it.

Baptism is like that. The water that we pour on people to baptize them is a symbol for judgment. Why would we do that to someone?

Because the meaning of baptism is that we all have to go through judgment. We all have to stand before God to see if he'll let us into heaven. If we stand by ourselves we can't get into heaven and the flood of God's judgment will condemn us forever. BUT, if we stand with Jesus for judgment then we do get into heaven because Jesus took our judgment for us at the cross. It means if we believe in Jesus we can come out of the judgment flood and we will be clean and have heaven and life forever.

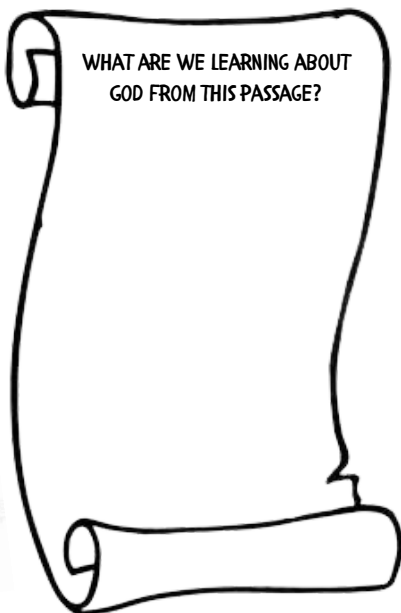
