Do we work to show other people the love of Jesus? Oh yes!!

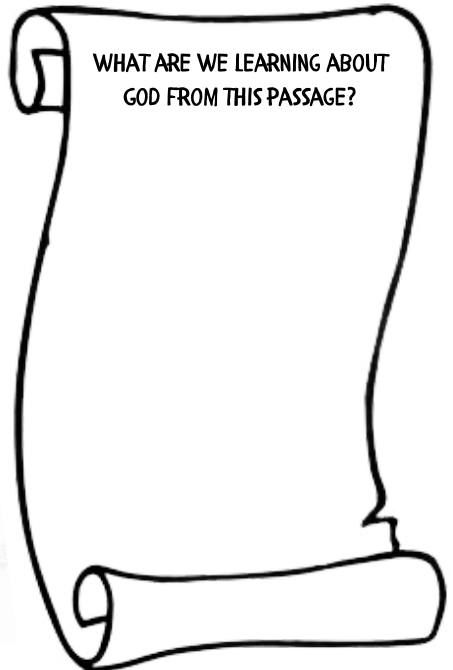



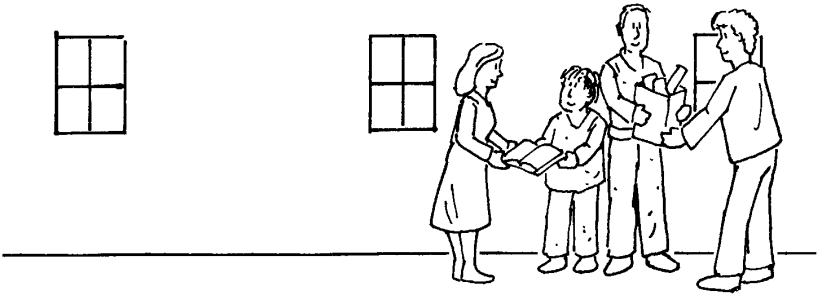


After Paul worked to present the word of God, it continued to work in their lives.
