And the grandpa says, "That's right. When I was your age, television was called books. And this is a special book. It was the book my father used to read to me when I was sick, and I used to read it to your father. And today I'm gonna read it to you." And the grandson asks, "Has it got any sports in it?" And Grandpa says : Are you kidding? Fencing, fighting, torture, revenge, giants, monsters, chases, escapes, true love, miracles..." Well then the grandpa starts reading about Buttercup and Westley and how they fall in love and they're flirting a bunch as Buttercup orders Westley around, do this, do that, and Westley just says, "As you wish" and one day Buttercup and Westley are flirting and then they kiss...AND

The Grandson interrupts his grandpa reading and says, "Hold it, hold it. What is this? Are you trying to trick me? Where's the sports? Is this a kissing book?" The book in the Bible we are talking about today is Ephesians 5, and it's got a bunch of verses about two people who love each other and they flirt and they get married and have this great married life. The Princess Bride is about more than just two people in love and so is Ephesians 5. Which means God thinks love and marriage is a big deal if he put this stuff in the Bible that's just about love and marriage. And the point is you're going to hear people in the world say all kinds of stuff about love and marriage and what family is all about and you've got to decide: Are you going to listen to the world or are you going to listen to God's Word about what love and marriage and family is all about? Because they say very different things.

Ephesians 5 says marriage and love between one man and one woman is a very good and special thing and that marriage and love is also hard but still good. Did you know the Bible says that the church is the Bride of Christ? It's a metaphor, a picture the Bible uses to describe how devoted Jesus is to us and how we are supposed to be devoted to him. He is so devoted to us Jesus actually died to save us and make us his Bride. And now we look forward to the biggest party celebration to come when he returns for us, his love.

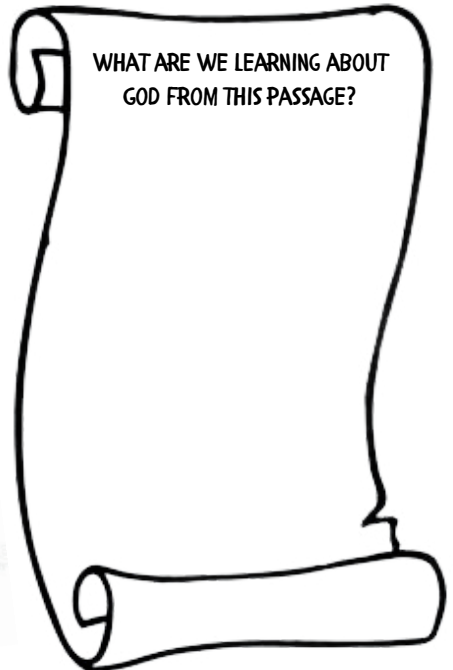

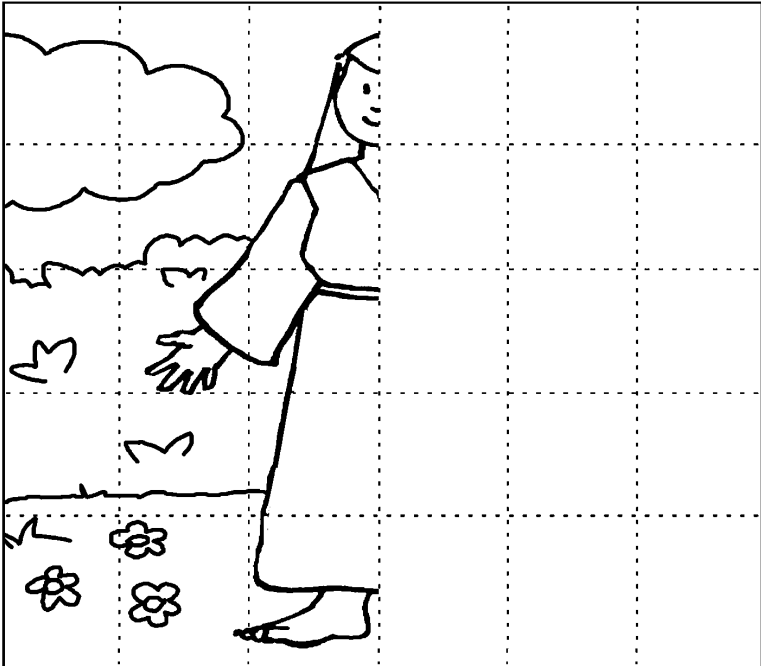
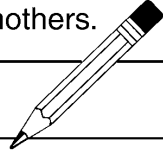
